Topical Workgroups

Purpose: Recommend strategies in each of 5 topical areas that have high potential to serve Michigan's GHG emission reduction goals in an equitable manner.

Objectives:

1. Develop a baseline understanding of current carbon emission levels, opportunities and barriers to reducing emissions, and equity considerations.
2. Discuss decarbonization strategies, in consideration of the opportunities and barriers
3. Develop a bulleted list of recommendations for what needs to happen in the next 9 years—by 2030—to achieve Michigan's 2050 climate goal.

NOTE: Workgroups are NOT being asked to achieve consensus on recommendations
