# GOVERNANCE PROCEDURES

## Proposed Modified Language

### Section 1: Regular Meetings

Regular meetings of the Michigan Council on Climate Solutions (Council) may be held quarterly, or as needed, for the transaction of business as may be brought before the Council. Business that the Council may perform shall be conducted at a public meeting of the committee held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275, **with the exception that due to the advisory nature of the Council, it may choose to hold meetings in whole or in part, electronically by telephonic or video conferencing as long the meetings are noticed in the same manner and the public is allowed to attend in accordance with provisions of the Open Meetings Act.**

## Proposed Adjusted Timeline

**July 27** – Energy Intensive Industries – (extended to 2 hours), discuss council meeting dates through end of February

**Aug 24** – Equity Presentation, start reviewing recommendations from workgroups if available (recommendations currently due at the end of September)

**September 28** – Review workgroup recommendations

**October 26** – Review workgroup recommendations

**November 23** – Review workgroup recommendations

## Proposed Adjusted Timeline

December 28 - (propose reschedule to December 14) – Review outline of draft plan, year-end status report for the Governor

January 11, 2022 (proposed) – Discuss draft plan to be released for public comment

January 15, 2022 (proposed) - Release draft plan for public comment – 28 days

February 15, 2022 (proposed) – Discuss public comment received

February 21-25, 2022 (proposed) - Final plan delivered to Governor
