

S Level Certification


- Distribution System and Untreated Well systems
- Water main installation
- Water main break repairs
- Maintenance of Hydrants and Valves
- Storage tank operation and maintenance
- Booster station/pumps operation maintenance



D Level Certification

- Limited Treatment
- Well systems with some level of treatment

- Iron Removal
- Arsenic Removal
- Softening
- Chemical addition
 - Chlorine
 - Phosphate
 - Fluoride



F Level Certification

- Most Complex Level of Treatment
- Surface Water = Drinking Water
- Conventional Surface Water
 Treatment
- Microfiltration
