Welcome, Task Force Business

Meeting commenced at 1:00 p.m.

- Liesl welcomed everyone and attendance was taken.
- Liesl summarized the agenda. Mike Nystrom made a motion to approve the July 15, 2020, agenda and Dan seconded. The agenda was approved unanimously by voice vote.
- Mike Furmanski made a motion to approve the June 9, 2020, meeting minutes and Jim seconded. The minutes were approved unanimously by voice vote.

LiesI said meetings will be virtual for the foreseeable future. The Task Force members discussed and agreed that shorter meetings held more often is preferred. The Task Force agreed to keep the dates currently on the calendar but to shorten the virtual meetings to approximately 2.5 hours, and to add a few dates.
