SUBJECT: Report of Solid Waste Landfilled in Michigan for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025

In accordance with Section 11512(24) of Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, attached is the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy's (EGLE) Report of Solid Waste Landfilled in Michigan for FY 2025.

There was an overall 6.35 percent decrease in solid waste disposed in Michigan landfills last year:

- In FY 2025, 22,603,565.92 tons were disposed.
- In FY 2024, 24,136,619.52 tons were disposed.

Waste from Michigan residents and businesses decreased by 1,138,715.86 tons. Imported waste decreased by 394,337.74 tons. Total imported solid waste is approximately 18.02 percent of all waste disposed in Michigan landfills in FY 2025. The largest source of waste imports into Michigan continues to be from Canada at 14.11 percent of all waste disposed in Michigan landfills.

- In FY 2025, 4,072,915.43 tons of waste were disposed from other states and Canada.
- In FY 2024, 4,467,253.17 tons of waste were disposed from other states and Canada.

However, the life-cycle costs of disposal versus materials management can be significantly higher when factoring in the long-term expenses associated with waste disposal facilities.

Michigan landfills have a total of approximately 23 years of remaining disposal capacity based on the capacity used during FY 2025, additional permitted landfill capacity, and the total remaining capacity of facilities. Please note that this estimate does not take into consideration any projected increase or decrease in waste disposal rates, waste diversion programs, or any imposed restrictions, such as volume limitations, special conditions, or the waste import/export authorizations of each county. Furthermore, even modest success in implementing a materials management approach could extend disposal capacity beyond the currently projected 23 years.

## INTRODUCTION

Section 11512(24) of Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), requires all landfills in Michigan to “annually submit a report to the department and the county and municipality in which the landfill is located that specifies the tonnage and type of solid waste received by the landfill during the year itemized, to the extent possible, by county, state, or country of origin and the amount of remaining disposal capacity at the landfill. Remaining disposal capacity shall be calculated as the permitted capacity less waste in place for any area that has been constructed and is not yet closed plus the permitted capacity for each area that has a permit for construction under Part 115 but has not yet been constructed. The report shall be submitted within 45 days after the end of each state fiscal year. By January 31 of each year, the department shall submit to the legislature a report summarizing the information obtained under this subsection.” This report covers the period from October 1, 2024 - September 30, 2025, and is the thirtieth annual Report of Solid Waste Landfilled in Michigan as compiled from the information submitted by the individual landfills.

The landfills report the waste received by category using Re-TRAC Connect Michigan Solid Waste Authorization Program (Re-TRAC). For purposes of this report, MCW means municipal and commercial waste and is typically residential-like waste; IW means industrial waste; C&D means construction and demolition waste; ADC means alternate daily cover; and OTHER means asbestos, contaminated soils not used as ADC and technologically enhanced naturally occurring radioactive material (TENORM). For additional information on the waste types that fall within each of these categories, see the Waste Type Key found in Appendix A.

Amendments to Part 115 were passed in December 2022 and became effective March 29, 2023. Previously, Michigan landfills were required to report in volumes as cubic yards. Starting March 29, 2023, Michigan landfills are required to report in weight as tons. Re-TRAC records both cubic yards and tons using simple conversion factors<sup>1</sup>. Michigan required landfills to report in Re-TRAC starting fiscal year (FY) 2021, therefore, past data in tons is only available from FY 2021 to the current fiscal year.

## TOTAL WASTE DISPOSAL SUMMARY

Total waste disposed in Michigan’s 65 reporting landfills was reported at 22,603,565.92 tons, a decrease of 1,533,053.60 tons or about 6.35 percent over FY 2024 report data. Waste generated in Michigan decreased from 19,669,366.35 tons in the previous reporting period to 18,530,650.49 tons, a decrease of about 5.79 percent.

Total waste imported into Michigan landfills decreased from 4,467,253.17 tons in the previous reporting period to 4,072,915.43, a decrease of about 8.83 percent. Imported waste from other states and Canada make up about 18.02 percent of all waste disposed in Michigan landfills.

The largest source of imported waste continues to be from Canada, with reported total of 3,189,313.19 tons, down 275,391.34 tons or about 7.95 percent from FY 2024 report data. Imported waste from Canada makes up about 14.11 percent of all waste disposed in Michigan landfills. Waste reported from twelve other states totaled 883,602.24 tons, a decrease of about 118,946.40 tons over FY 2024 reported data.

### CAPACITY SUMMARY

As defined in Section 11512(24) of Part 115, “Remaining disposal capacity shall be calculated as the permitted capacity less waste in place for any area that has been constructed and is not yet closed plus the permitted capacity for each area that has a permit for construction under this part but has not yet been constructed.” Table 4 presents projected remaining disposal capacity, capacity used during the fiscal year, estimated years of remaining capacity (rounded to the nearest year) as reported by each facility, and an EGLE-calculated estimate of years of remaining capacity, for each facility, alphabetically. The data presented in Column C for each facility are based on site-specific calculations, which may vary among facilities. The data representing capacity used in FY 2025 and estimated years remaining, as calculated by each facility, are presented for informational purposes only. It should also be noted that the amount of waste received at each facility may differ from the capacity used during the FY depending on the type of waste disposed of and the degree of compaction.

EGLE used a simplistic formula to calculate estimated years of remaining capacity for each facility, using the data provided by each facility: Column A divided by Column B equals Column D. Although, in some cases, the facility-projected years of remaining capacity in Column C equals the calculated remaining capacity in Column D, it must be noted that each facility may have used a different formula to calculate their projected years of remaining capacity and, therefore, may differ from the calculations presented in Column D.

Based on current capacity used for FY 2025 and total remaining capacity, Michigan landfills have approximately 23 years of remaining disposal capacity left. These capacity values do not include any projected fluctuations in disposal rates, waste diversion programs, or any county-imposed restrictions such as volume limitations, any special conditions, or the waste import/export authorizations of each county.

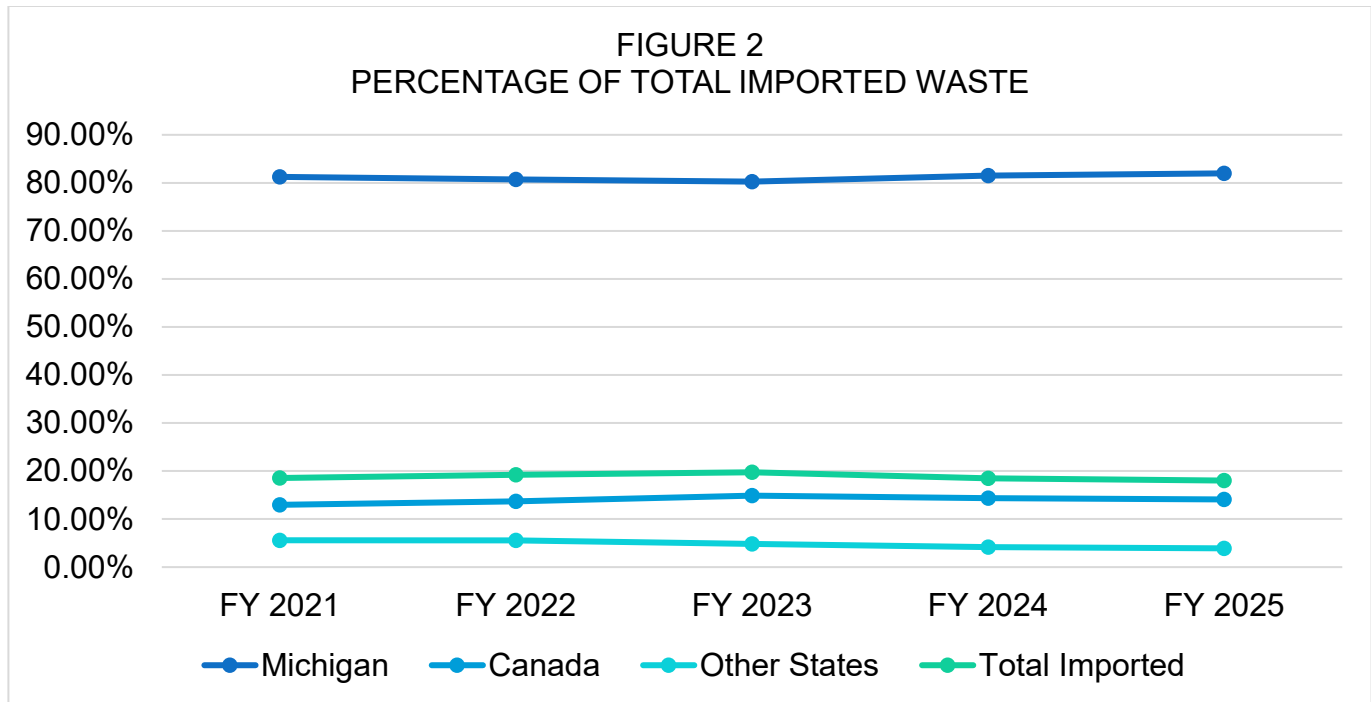
