**GENERAL PERMIT TO INSTALL PROGRAM
Facility Codes**

SRN

The State Registration Number (SRN) is an alphanumeric identifier assigned to a stationary source by the Air Quality Division (AQD). The SRN is unique to the physical location of a source (except for portable equipment) and is comprised of a letter followed by four digits (i.e., A1497). The SRN for a facility can be found on the Michigan Air Emissions Reporting System (MAERS) forms that are submitted annually to the AQD or on a previously issued permit. If the application is for a new facility or one that has not had previous business with the AQD an SRN may not exist. The AQD will assign an SRN during the review of the permit application.

NAICS

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) provides a numeric code that identifies an industry. It has replaced the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) system. NAICS was developed jointly by the USA, Canada, and Mexico to provide new comparability in statistics about business activity across North America. A six-digit code is preferred for a more exact description.
