SECOND AMENDED OPINION AND ORDER

On September 29, 2023, the Petitioner, Savoy Energy, LP, filed a Second Motion to Amend Opinion and Order to Extend Time to Drill Well requesting relief from Order No. 04-2022, effective September 7, 2022. Order No. 04-2022 (i) recognized the 40-acre Ryznar 1-20 drilling unit formed pursuant to Order 18-2007; (ii) appointed Savoy Energy LP as the operator of the Ryznar 1-20 well and directed the Petitioner to complete the drilling of the well within 180 days from the effective date of that Order; (iii) ordered the statutory pooling of all properties, parts of properties, and interests within the drilling unit; and (iv) authorized the Petitioner to recover costs and additional compensation from the parties subject to the statutory pooling. No answers in opposition to the original Petition in this cause were filed for Order No. 04-2022, and the Petitioner was the only party to this cause.

After granting Petitioner's earlier Motion to Amend Opinion and Order No. 04-2022, which Motion was dated February 16, 2023, the Supervisor issued the Amended Opinion and Order dated April 10, 2023, which extended the drilling deadline for the Ryznar No. 1-20 Well to December 6, 2023.

The Petitioner, in its Second Motion, now states that, due to being in various stages of seeking other necessary permits from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the City of Romulus to drill the well, it is still not able to drill the Ryznar 1-20 before the currently effective deadline of December 6, 2023.

In its Second Motion, the Petitioner requests an additional extension of time to commence the drilling of the Ryznar 1-20 well until December 5, 2024. As directed, the Petitioner has served copies of its Second Motion on all pooled owners by mail sent on October 27, 2023. No answers in opposition to Petitioner's Second Motion were filed with the Supervisor.

DETERMINATION AND ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED :

Paragraph 3 of the Determination and Order section of the original Opinion and Order No. 04-2022, effective September 7, 2023, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

3. The Petitioner is named Operator of the Ryznar 1-20 well. The Operator shall commence the drilling of the Ryznar 1-20 well on or before September 30, 2024 (expiration date of current reentry permit), or the statutory pooling authorized in this Order shall be null and void as to all parties and interests. This pooling Order applies to the drilling of the Ryznar 1-20 well and any directional redrills from that well.

All other provisions of the original Opinion and Order No. 04-2022, effective September 7, 2022 (and the Amended Opinion and Order dated April 10, 2023) are reaffirmed.
