**ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULING ORDER AND ANSWER WITHDRAWAL  
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

The Petitioner, Trak Oil LLC, filed its Petition to amend Supervisor of Wells Order No. 07-2014 and approve a reconfigured Calvin 1 Unit to undisputed lands for the continuance of enhanced recovery operations on December 6, 2022.

The Collective Respondents, Dale Grohowski, Carl Grohowski, Kenneth Grohowski, Merle Bowers, Jr., Warren Smith, Jr., and Melissa Freer-Smith, husband and wife, Warren and Mildred Smith, husband and wife, Rita Miller, Kirsten Lunch (all oil, gas, and mineral owners), John T. McColley and Catherine McColley, husband and wife (surface owners), and Calvin Minerals Management, LLC (Lessee), by and through its attorney, Sara L. Cunningham filed an Answer and Request for a Pre-hearing Conference on January 16, 2023. The Respondents are surface owners, mineral owners, and or have leasehold interest in the current Calvin 1 Unit Area. They dispute Petitioner allegations, request the Supervisor of Wells deny the petition, and request their motion to convert hearing date to a pre-hearing conference be approved based on the complexity of issues.

In addition, Respondents, Lois Haines, Sarah Solano on behalf of Baker Forest Company, Inc., Pamela Douglas Trustee of the Gloria Hawks Estate, Mary J. Haines, Dick Whitcraft on behalf of WPS Wealth Advisors, LLC and DACK Investments, LLC, Justin and Rachelle Elliott, all mineral owners of uncontested acreage within the existing Calvin 1 Unit, filed answers in support of the Petition between January 10 and 12, 2023.

The scheduled hearing was converted to a prehearing conference held January 23, 2023, resulting in a scheduling order for exchange of motions/answers, lists of witnesses, and exhibits leading to a May 15, 2023, hearing date. In the meantime, the Petitioner and Respondents, with counsel, continued to work on resolution of issues.

On April 18, 2023, the Petitioner and Respondents, through their respective attorneys submitted a Stipulated Withdrawal of Answer and Amendment to Petition. With the withdrawal of the answer, Cause Number 13-2023 became uncontested and could move forward as an uncontested evidentiary hearing held pursuant to R 324.1205(1)(c).

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

The hearing on Cause 13-2022 scheduled for May 15-17, 2023, in Lansing, Michigan, is hereby cancelled, and Petitioner is directed to submit testimony in support of its petition by verified statements pursuant to R 324.1205(2).
