General Overview



What is MiEnviro Portal?

MiEnviro is the system used to submit information to the Air Quality Division.

Paper forms, applications, letters by mail to the AQD	All forms, applications, and information submitted to the AQD in MiEnviro
Email	Staff may email directly, plus there are system email notifications
Phone Calls	Not changing
Virtual Meetings	Not changing
In Person Meetings	Not changing

Terminology

Term	MiEnviro Definition/Term
Submission	Any application, form, or report submitted to the AQD
Notifications	System generated emails
Evaluations	Inspections
Site Admin	The person at your company who manages user access to your site
Certifier	The person at your company who can submit forms and reports
Site	Your company/facility
Schedule	Forms and reports added to your site for easy access



General Process for Submitting Information

- 1. Create a user account
- 2. Access a site or sites
- 3. Access forms, applications, and reports from your Dashboard
- 4. Add/remove/edit data, submit forms, applications and reports.
- 5. Receive/read system email notifications about your submissions.
- 6. AQD reviews and approves submissions **OR** AQD reviews and requests more information (Correction Request)
- 7. Address any corrections and resubmit.



View and Access Information

- Permit records
- Evaluations (Inspections) Inspection Reports, Test results, all documents relating to an inspection
- Emissions (if you are required to report annual emissions)
- Compliance reports
- Violation Notices
- Enforcement actions
- All documents related to a site



Permit Application Packages

A **Submission Package** is a group of applications/forms used to apply for a Permit to Install, General Permit to Install or a modification to a Renewable Operating Permit.

- Each submission package has 2 or more individual applications.
- Submission packages will have required applications and optional (as needed) applications.
- Application Equipment Inventory Form is a required form in a package.



Example of PTI Submission Package

- There are approximately 25 applications **AVAILABLE** within the PTI NEW submission package. Some will be required, some are available "As Needed"
- Buttons to Begin, Continue Draft, Delete Draft, and Delete Package are readily available.

Master Facility Inventory

Each site with an Air Permit in MiEnviro will have a Master Facility Inventory (MFI). The MFI is a list of equipment at your site.

The MFI includes:

- Release Points (stacks)
- Control Devices
- Control Paths
- Emission Units (may include exempt EUs for ROPs)
- Unit Processes (Source Classification Codes (SCCs))
- Flexible Groups (grouped Emission Units for ease of permitting only)



Updating the Master Facility Inventory

Sites update their MFI by submitting one of the four forms below. All four forms are identical.

Form Name	Who	When/Where
Annual Equipment Inventory Review Form	Sites required to submit an Annual Emissions Report	Access 9/1, submit by 11/1
Off-Permit Equipment Inventory Update	Any site who wants to change equipment data	Access *any time from your Dashboard in the As Needed category
Application Equipment Inventory Form	Sites who are applying for a new or modification Permit to Install (PTI) or General Permit	Access from Start a New Form screen
Notification of Installation	Sites who install permitted equipment	Access from Dashboard

*For sites required to submit the Annual Emissions Report, do not use the Off-Permit form during the Annual EIR period of September-November.

Schedules

MiEnviro refers to forms and reports added to your site by the AQD as Schedules. The types of forms and reports added as Schedules depends on the compliance requirements for your sites. Sites will access the forms and reports to submit required information to the AQD.

There are "general" forms available if you need to submit something to the AQD and you aren't finding the appropriate Schedule on your site.

Examples of Schedules with a due date	Examples of As Needed Schedules
Annual Emissions Report	Notification of Installation
Annual Equipment Inventory Review Form	Air Visible Emissions Test
ROP Annual Compliance Certification	Air Malfunction Abatement Plan



Dashboard

- The MiEnviro Dashboard allows a user to find applications, forms and reports that need to be submitted.
- Items on the dashboard are sorted by category
 - Click on each category to find different applications, forms and reports specific to your site

 have one or more places
 available for
 attachments.
 * Project Description Attachment
 Attach the written project description
- Attach documents such as Excel spreadsheets, pictures, Word documents, maps, charts, etc.
