SUBJECT: Complete Distribution System Materials Inventory (CDSMI) – Final
Submittal Instructions

This memo provides additional information on the Complete Distribution System Materials Inventory (CDSMI) required by the lead and copper provisions of the Michigan Safe Drinking Water Act, 1976 PA 399, as amended (Act 399). To meet State and Federal requirements a CDSMI must be submitted to EGLE by **October 16, 2024**. Please note “distribution systems limited in extent” are those with minimal distribution infrastructure, often consisting of a service line(s) directly connecting a well(s) or wellhouse(s) to the building(s) served. Common examples include apartment complexes, nursing home facilities, and senior living centers.

The purpose of the CDSMI is to characterize, record, and maintain a comprehensive inventory of distribution system materials, including service line materials on both public and customer property. This should include the establishment or continuation of a comprehensive record management system that is updated regularly as inventory is added, changed, or confirmed. The focus of this memo is to provide additional information regarding the final submittal of the CDSMI. Visit Michigan.gov/LCR for the documents titled “CDSMI Submission Information” and “CDSMI for Water Supplies with Distribution Systems Limited in Extent Form” which provide detailed instructions on how to submit the required CDSMI documents. On or before **October 16, 2024**, submit the CDSMI for Water Supplies with Distribution Limited in Extent Form to EGLE.
