Review of the Dimondale/Windsor Septage Receiving Facility Operating Plan received on November 21, 2005, is complete. The purpose of the review was to ensure that the plan addressed all of the required elements listed in Part 117, Septage Waste Servicers, Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. The operating plan is approved. The receiving facility must operate in accordance with the approved plan. It is understood that the facility only provides service to Ace Rentals and Ball Septic. If a change in operations or conditions is anticipated, please file an amendment to the plan at least thirty days prior to the proposed date for implementation. Please note that this approval is conditioned such that a copy of the public notice is provided to this office within 30 days.

The Dimondale / Windsor WWTP are currently allowing Ball Septic and Ace Rentals to discharge at the plant. We have decided at this time not to except anymore septic haulers. The map attached to this letter shows exactly where Ball and Ace discharge.

The WWTP is not able to treat grease of any kind. Since Ball Septic accepts food establishment septage we treat only the effluent from his Belt or Vac press which is located onsite of the plant. Ace Rentals is allowed to discharge before the screens at the headworks because he only accepts domestic septage.

The WWTP has capacity for 750,000 gpd but is running at 140,000 gpd. We have a ME of 3lbs of 5 day BOD.

The service area for the WWTP is Dimondale and Windsor Twp. South of Lansing Rd.

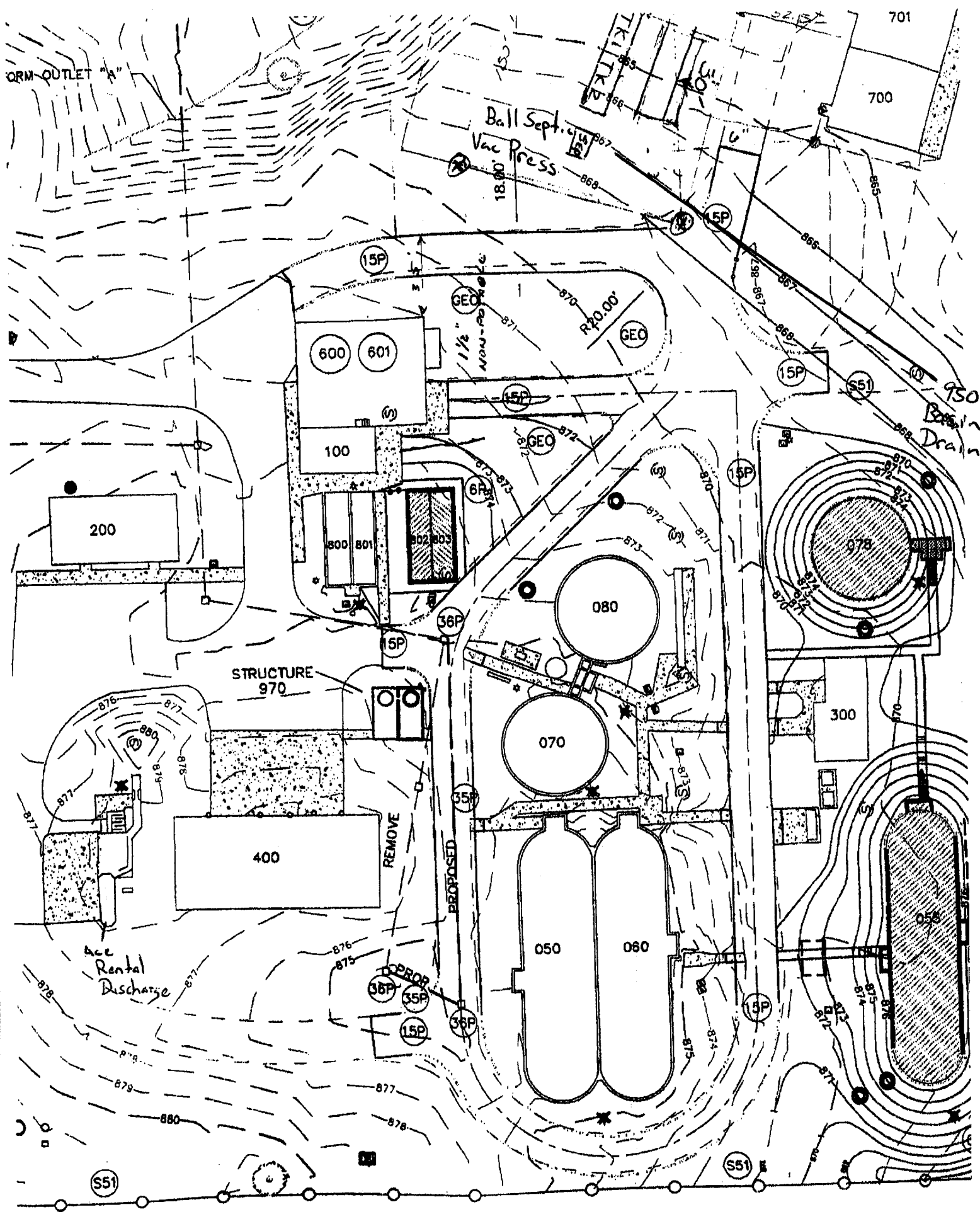
The regular business hours are 7:00am – 3:00pm Monday through Friday.
