Septage Receiving Facility Operating Plan

The Iron Mountain/Kingsford Joint Sewage Treatment Plant (POTW) accepts waste from recreational vehicles (RVs) only. The POTW does not accept septage from any other sources i.e. (septic tanks, portable toilets or holding tanks). RV owners shall be responsible for discharging the waste from their units and any cleanup necessary.

Acceptance Location –

Address – Box 88 Park Drive, Kingsford, Michigan, 49802

There is a hole in the POTW driveway that feeds directly into the main sewer pipe to the plant. Hole is located by the plants front gate.

Hours of Operation –

The POTW will accept RV waste from 7am – 2:30pm Monday – Friday.

Fees –

There will not be a fee charged for the discharge of RV waste.

Categories Accepted –

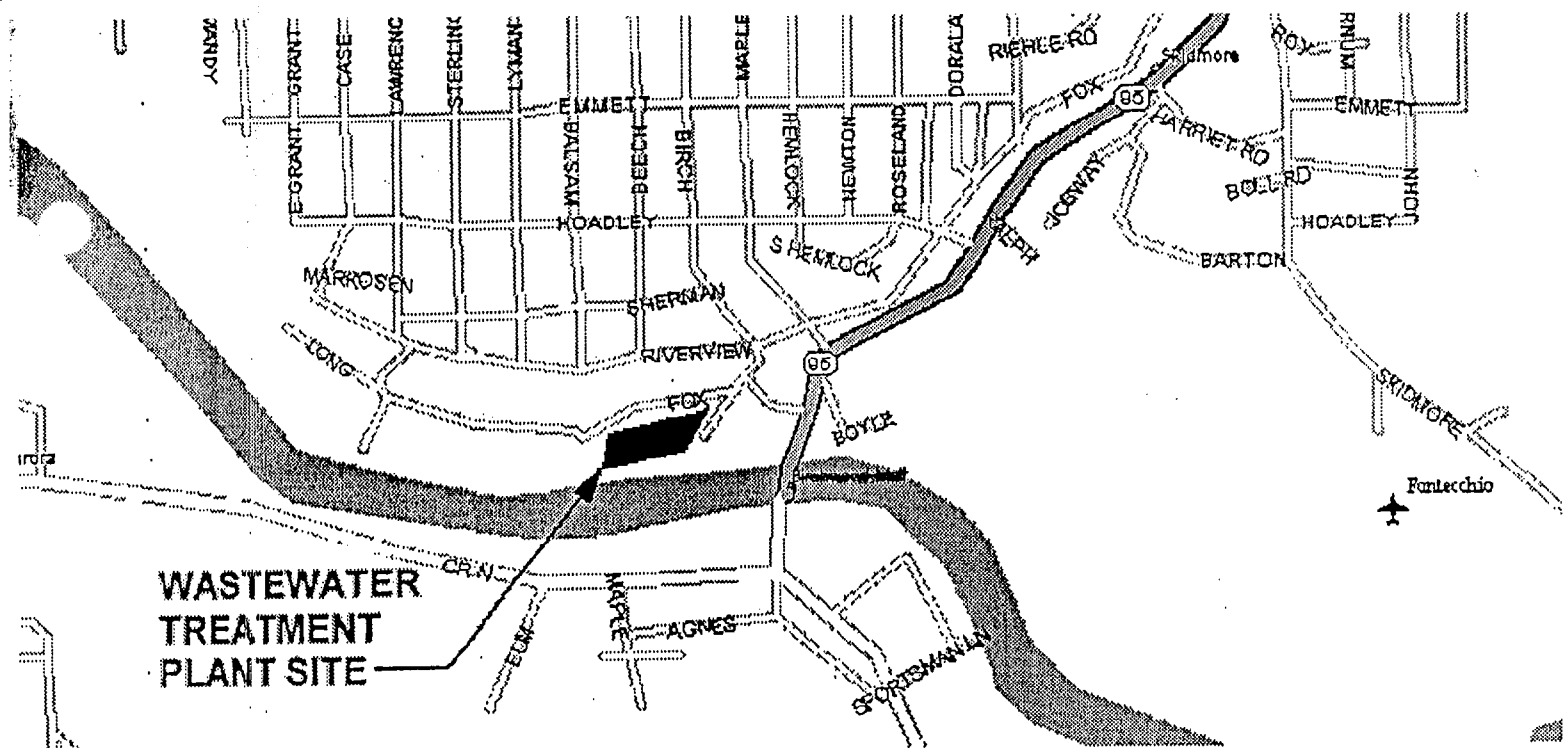
The POTW will only accept waste from RV's. Septage, holding tanks, cesspools, or portable toilet waste will not be accepted.

Service area –

The POTW will accept RV waste from residence of the local area and those visiting the area needing the service.

Other Conditions –

The POTW will maintain a log of discharges.
