

## VEHICLE SEAL AND LICENSE GUIDANCE

### EGLE Vehicle License

- Each vehicle is issued a separate license by EGLE.
- EGLE vehicle license is issued once during the five (5) year licensing cycle.
- The license is non-transferable.
- EGLE highly recommends that you laminate the license.
- The license must be carried in the vehicle at all times.
- The license must be displayed upon request of the department, peace officer, or an official of a certified health department.

Part 117 of the NREPA, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires this license be carried in the licensed vehicle at all times. Failure to comply may result in fine and / or imprisonment.</p>

Be aware of your license expiration date. It is the same as your business license expiration date. Failure to renew will result in the expiration of your business and vehicle license.

### EGLE Vehicle Seals

- The seals are issued once during the five (5) year license cycle.
- Be advised that the vehicle seal is not a license but rather proof the business paid their **annual fee**.
- Remove any previous EGLE Septage Waste Program seals.
- **Place the new seals on each side of the vehicle cab – not the tank.**

- Letter the vehicle with the words “Licensed Septage Hauler” along with the EGLE issued business license number in letters 2 inches or larger. This lettering may be placed on the vehicle tank. Please see the example below for details.

- Each seal has a unique ID number associated with each licensed vehicle. This along with other vehicle details can be reviewed on the EGLE Septage Haulers Directory available on the Septage Waste Program website at [Michigan.gov/EGLESeptage](http://Michigan.gov/EGLESeptage). Please check this directory to ensure the information listed is correct.
- Different colored seals coincide with a given five (5) year period and different colors denote disposal type – either disposal on land or at a septage waste receiving facility.
