

**COMPLIANCE WITH
FEDERAL LAW STATEMENT**

Compliance with Federal Law Statement

The following laws listed in 40 CFR 270.3 may apply to the issuance of a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act permit.

- The Wild and Scenic Rivers Act
- The National Historic Preservation Act of 1966
- The Endangered Species Act
- The Coastal Zone Management Act
- The Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act

A review of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife's "County List of Federal and Threatened, Endangered, and Proposed Species from Michigan Natural Features Inventory" March 2025, indicates that there are several listed endangered, threatened and candidate species potentially present in Midland County and immediately surrounding counties including: the Rusty patch bumblebee, the snuffbox, the piping plover, the Northern riffleshell, and the Prairie white fringed orchard. While these species maybe potentially present, they have not been identified in or near the facilities. See the Environmental Assessment Module B4 of this renewal application for more details.

The Dow Chemical Company has no knowledge that any of these laws are applicable to the Midland Plant or Salzburg Landfill site.
