

## NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION

Ford Motor Company; MID 005 057 005  
Hazardous Waste Management Facility Postclosure  
Operating License Issuance

September 30, 2022

On September 30, 2022, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Materials Management Division (MMD), issued a Hazardous Waste Management Facility Postclosure Operating License (License) for Ford Motor Company (Ford), pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and the administrative rules promulgated thereunder. The issuance of the License followed a public comment period that was held from August 15, 2022, to September 28, 2022. No comments were received during the public comment period.

The License requires Ford to continue postclosure care and monitoring of the two closed hazardous waste landfill cells at the Ford River Raisin Warehouse facility located at 3200 East Elm Avenue, Monroe, Michigan.
