

NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION

Granger Land Development Company
Closed Hazardous Waste Landfill
Hazardous Waste Management Facility Postclosure Operating License

On September 28, 2023, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Materials Management Division (MMD), issued a Hazardous Waste Management Facility Postclosure Operating License (License) to Granger Land Development Company (Granger), pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and the administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

The issuance of the License followed a public comment period from August 13, 2023, to September 26, 2023. Comments were received from one party. A summary of changes made to the draft License to address comments received and the reason for each change are presented in the Response to Comments.

The License authorizes Granger to continue postclosure monitoring and maintenance of the Granger Grand River Landfill, a closed hazardous waste landfill facility, located at 8550 West Grand River Highway, Grand Ledge, Michigan. The License will expire ten years from the date of issuance.
