SUBJECT: Determination of Technical Adequacy for Hazardous Waste Management Facility Operating License Renewal Application; Wayne Disposal, Inc.; MID 048 090 633, Waste Data System Number 395812

The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Materials Management Division (MMD), has completed a technical review of the November 5, 2021, Hazardous Waste Management Facility Operating License renewal application (Application) from Wayne Disposal, Inc., for its facility located at 49350 North Interstate-94 Service Drive, Belleville, Michigan. The review was conducted under the administrative rules promulgated pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and the administrative rules promulgated thereunder. Based on this review, the Application is technically adequate.

With this determination of technical adequacy, the MMD has drafted the enclosed operating license and fact sheet. The MMD is making the draft license available for public input and will hold a public informational meeting, and a public hearing as announced in the enclosed notice. The public notice is scheduled to appear in *The Belleville Independent* on August 14, 2025.

The public information meeting and public hearing will be held on:

- Thursday, September 18, 2025, from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Wayne County Community College District, Ted Scott Campus, 9555 Haggerty Road, Belleville, Michigan

The public comment period for the proposed draft License begins on August 14, 2025, and ends on September 29, 2025, 5:00 p.m. The MMD expects to make a final licensing decision by September 30, 2025.

If significant comments are received during the public comment period on the draft licensing decision, or during a formal public hearing, this schedule may be updated to account for any additional time needed to address comments.

Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy Notice of Intent to Issue Hazardous Waste Management Facility Operating License Public Informational Meeting and Public Hearing for Wayne Disposal, Inc.

The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Materials Management Division (MMD), and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), hereby gives notice of its intent to issue a hazardous waste management facility operating license (License), for Wayne Disposal, Inc., pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and the administrative rules promulgated thereunder. The License would allow the facility to begin storing hazardous waste in containers, and to continue disposing of hazardous waste, certain radiological materials, and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB), waste in its hazardous waste landfill facility located at 49350 North Interstate-94 Service Drive, Belleville, Michigan. The draft License includes an expansion of disposal volume and the addition of hazardous waste storage.

EGLE is hosting a public informational meeting about the facility and a public hearing to receive comments on the draft License. The public informational meeting will start with an open house for residents to come and talk to EGLE and U.S. EPA staff one on one, ask questions, and learn about the facility in general. The open house will be followed up by a presentation about the facility's application and draft License, and a question-and-answer session with a panel. The public meeting will be followed by a public hearing where interested individuals will have an opportunity to submit oral or written comments on the draft License into the formal record. All individuals attending the public hearing who intend to speak are requested to register by filling out a comment card.
