

## **HELPFUL HINTS TO AID IN COMPLETING YOUR LIQUID INDUSTRIAL WASTE APPLICATION**

### **READ THE LETTER WITH YOUR APPLICATION!!! LETTER WILL SPECIFY WHICH APPLICATION TO COMPLETE!!!**

#### 1) **PERMIT & REGISTRATION** - NEW OR RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

- a) Completely read the instructions for permit and registration renewals.
- b) Check Safer Website ([www.safer.org](http://www.safer.org)) OR the SMS system website (<http://ai.fmcsa.dot.gov/SMS/Default.aspx>).
- c) Provide copy of MCS-90 (<http://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/forms/print/MCS-90.htm>)

**Note:** Provide a copy of the MCS-90 (Insurance) which lists primary coverage. Also include a copy of the MCS-90 for any excess coverage, if applicable. LIW coverage must be a minimum of \$750,000 and a minimum of \$1,000,000 coverage for hazardous waste. **For Hazardous Material (Waste) coverage** - if you have vehicles with capacities above 3,500 water gallons and are using them to transport hazardous material then \$5,000,000 coverage is required.

- d) Include certification initials (Page 4, Part II for Liquid Industrial Waste (LIW) and (Page 2 of the Uniform Hazardous Waste application) that are the same as the person signing the application.
- e) The “**entire fleet**” of the company’s vehicles (not just the ones that transport in Michigan) are to be identified on the application.
- f) New Transporters complete EQP 5150 (Site Identification Form) to obtain a number or update a number prior to submittal of the application.

**Note: there is a \$50.00 Charge to obtain a new Site Identification Number. There is no charge to update an issued number, unless that update involves a physical change of location or a change in ownership.**

- g) Permit Fee is only required every 3 years.

#### 2) **REGISTRATION** - RENEWAL APPLICATIONS ONLY

- a) Read Instructions for Renewal Only

#### 3) **LIW** – NEW OR RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

- a) **LIW Transporters Only:** Read the appropriate instructions for either a Permit and Registration Application or Registration Only Applications for LIW. Complete Attachment A.

b) **National Uniform Hazardous Materials Transporters** that also transport LIW provide the following:

- i) .. Attachment A
- ii) . A copy of the National Credential
- iii) .. A copy of Page 1 from the most recent Uniform Program
- iv) Registration/Permit application.
- v) .. Permit Fee and Registration Fee is waived

4) **LIW Fee Calculations**

5) **National Uniform Hazardous Materials Transporters** may utilize Page 1 of their most recent National Program Application to calculate the appropriate LIW fees.

Example: From Page 1 Hazardous Material % is 25%  
From Page 1 Michigan IRP Mile % is 10%  
From Page 1 Power Units are 35

1.2A Power Units **35**

1.2B Transportation activity involving LIW 100% -25%= . **75**

**(Note: Other documentation can be submitted to justify less than 100%)**

1.2C Transportation mileage in Michigan . **10**

35 vehicles X 75% (0.75) X 10% (0.10) = 2.6 vehicles. Round up to the next highest number = 3 vehicles X \$50 = \$150

6) **LIW Only Transporters**

- a) Transportation less than 100% provide documentation
- b) Transportation mileage in Michigan less than 100% provide documentation

OR

PAY FULL FEE (\$50 PER VEHICLE)
