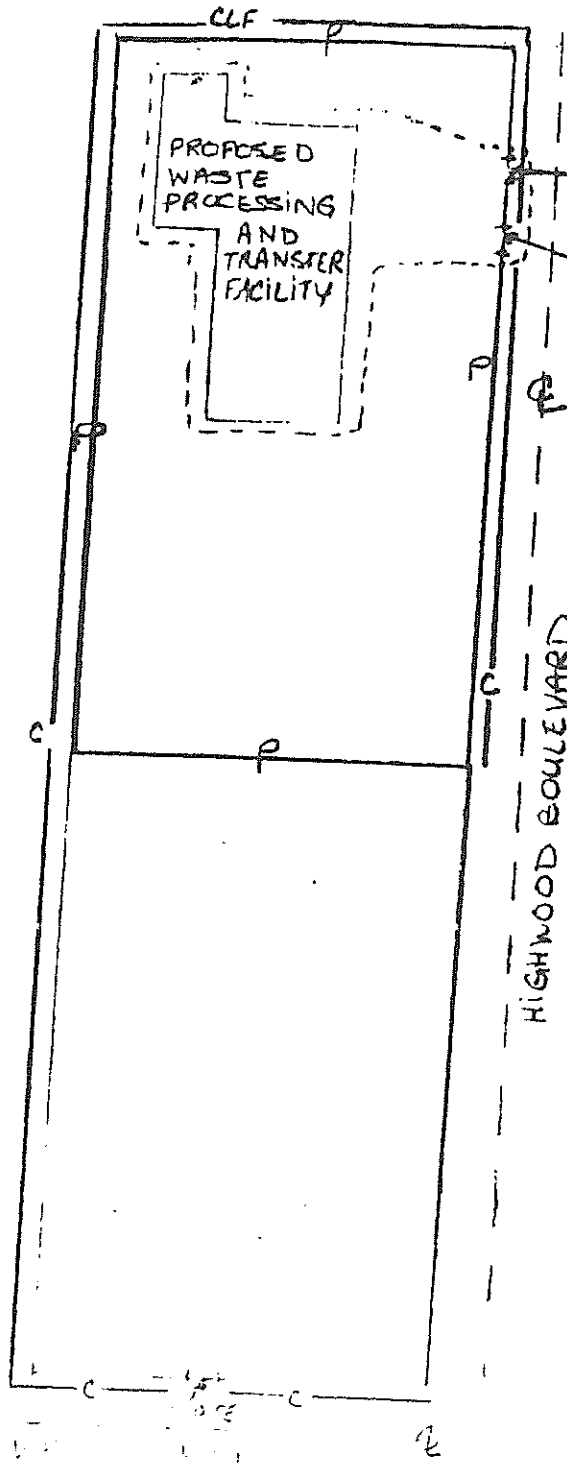
Description of Waste Types Accepted (as part of the Application for a Permit to Construct a Solid Waste Disposal Area):

All waste acceptable for landfilling in a disposal facility licensed under Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the State of Michigan Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), may be accepted at the proposed facility, with the exception of large quantities of industrial and municipal process wastes such as sludges, and soils, or other waste generally not suitable for transfer activities. Waste defined as "Prohibited Waste" under Part 115 rules, with the exception of Yard Clippings, will not be accepted at the proposed processing and transfer facility. Yard Clippings may be accepted at the facility but would not be sent for landfill disposal but instead re-loaded and directed to a compost or other recycling facility in compliance with Part 115 rules.

Recyclables such as fiber, plastic, metal, glass, wood, and tires, may also be accepted at the facility for processing.

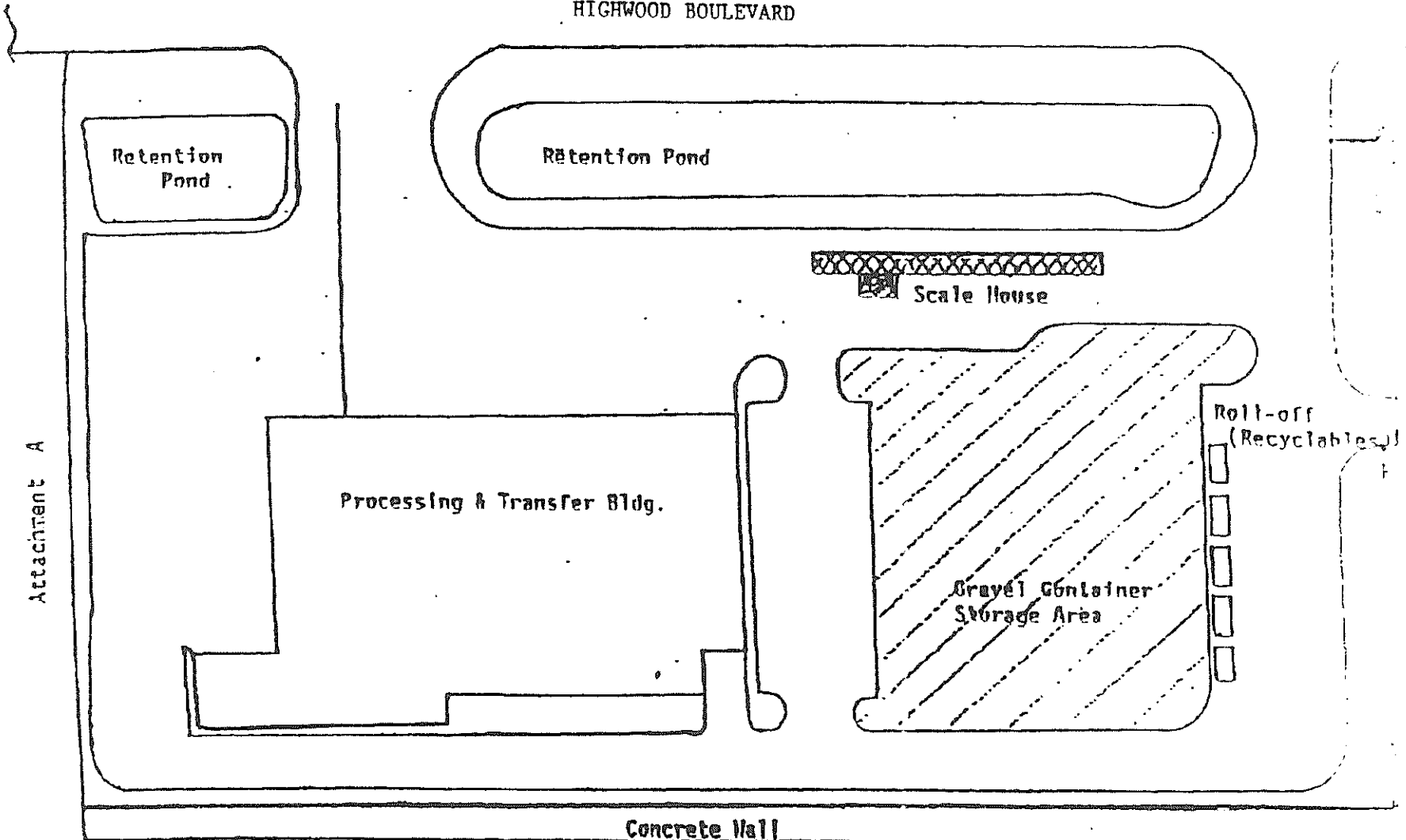

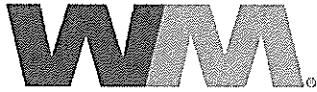
