**STIPULATED ORDER GRANTING
MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM JUDGMENT**

At a session of this Court held in the Circuit Courtroom, City of Mason,
County of Ingham, State of Michigan, on the 14th day of July, 2008

For the reasons set forth on the record on May 7, 2008, the Joint Motion for Relief From Judgment Pursuant to MCR 2.612(C) filed on behalf of Defendant JP Morgan Chase Bank (f/k/a NBD Bank, N.A.) and Third-Party Defendants Gerald J. Mansour, George J. Mansour, Robert A. Stork, Patricia A. Stork, Clarence D'Aigle,

Betty D'Aigle, Roy Diring and Mary Diring (deceased), is GRANTED, relieving each of them and Third-Party Defendants Margaret Thompson and Frances Thompson (deceased) (hereinafter collectively "the Remaining Perc Defendants") from any further obligations imposed by the Consent Decree.

Defendant JP Morgan Chase Bank shall reimburse the Plaintiff \$10,000 in past costs and \$22,123.14 in claimed oversight costs within 60 days of this Order's entry. Third-Party Defendants Gerald J. Mansour, George J. Mansour, Robert A. Stork, Patricia A. Stork, Clarence D'Aigle, Betty D'Aigle, Roy Diring and Mary Diring (deceased) shall jointly and severally reimburse Defendant JP Morgan Chase Bank \$5,000 within 60 days of this Order's entry, and Third-Party Defendants Margaret Thompson and Frances Thompson (deceased) shall jointly and severally reimburse Defendant JP Morgan Chase Bank \$5,000 within 60 days of this Order's entry.
