The Michigan Department of Natural Resources and Environment proposes to reissue a discharge permit to: the Pall Corporation for the groundwater remediation treatment facility located at 600 South Wagner Road, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48103. The applicant operates a treatment facility for remediation of contaminated groundwater. The applicant discharges treated groundwater to an unnamed tributary of Honey Creek, in the NW1/4, NE1/4, Section 26, Town 2 S, Range 5 E, Washtenaw County.

The draft permit includes the following modifications to the previously-issued permit. The final effluent limitation for chronic toxicity and the monitoring requirements for oxalic acid have been deleted because these pollutants are not being discharged at levels of concern. The short-term waste characterization study has been deleted as these requirements have been fulfilled. The requirement for a storm water pollution prevention plan has been deleted since there are neither industrial activities nor industrial storm water exposure on site.

Comments or objections to the draft permit received by May 3, 2010, will be considered in the final decision to issue the permit.
