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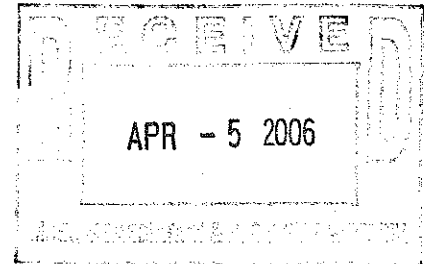

SUBJECT: Groundwater Discharge Authorization Permit  
Permit No. GEN-0080  
Designated Name: Gelman Sciences Inc

Staff of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Bureau (WB) met with you on March 31, 2006, to conduct an inspection and to clarify the current status of the groundwater discharge for which permit no. GEN-0080 was issued.

Permit No. GEN-0080 was issued to Gelman Sciences Inc. for the discharge within the Evergreen Subdivision on June 28, 1998, for groundwater remediation. No Application for Reissuance was submitted by the due date of June 16, 1998, and permit no. GEN-0080 expired December 12, 1998. After some discussion with your attorney, you decided having the option to discharge to groundwater was the course of action you would like to follow.

Based upon my inspection and file review, I believe the correct classification for this facility is a 2213(5) Permit by Rule-Certification for the discharge of wastewater which is associated with a department approved groundwater remediation, and which is discharged outside the plume of contamination. Be certain to include important changes such as corporate name change and contact information. I am also including a copy of *Frequently Asked Questions*. Please complete the enclosed *Groundwater Permit Application*, and mail it to the following address by April 28, 2006:
