**Aquatic Nuisance Control Permit Application and Annual Fees**

Effective November 1, 2021 – October 31, 2022

Fees effective for permit applications received November 1, 2021, through October 31, 2022<sup>1</sup>, and annual fees for multi-year permits issued November 1, 2021, through October 31, 2022<sup>2</sup>. Fees for certificates of coverage have not been changed.

Certificate of Coverage: \$75

Individual Permits:

- a) Less than ½ acre: \$80
- b) ½ acre or more but less than 5 acres: \$225
- c) 5 acres or more but less than 20 acres: \$450
- d) 20 acres or more but less than 100 acres: \$875
- e) 100 acres or more: \$1,600

The fees described above are an increase from the previous fees which were in place from November 1, 2014 through October 31, 2021. Annual fees for previously issued multi-year permits will remain unchanged until those permits are reissued.
