State High Water Infrastructure Grants

Sample Letter of Organizational Resolution of Support

State High Water Infrastructure Grant applications submitted to the Water Resources Division of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) by local units of government must include a Resolution of Support or equivalent authorization from the local legislative body as part of their supporting documentation for their application. All resolutions submitted must contain the following items:

- An overview of the planned project, highlighting why it's important
- Identification of property on which any project work will occur
- Explicit support for submission of the application to the Water Resources Division
- Date of vote, or date resolution was passed

EGLE's Water Resource Division has developed the attached sample as example Letter of Organizational Support.

**Resolution Approving Submission of Water Resources Division Grant
Application for Lakeview Park Improvements**

WHEREAS the developed portion of the park needs improvement.

WHEREAS the undeveloped portion of the park is not linked to the developed portion and needs passive recreation activities.

WHEREAS funding is available from the U.S. Department of Commerce through the Water Resources Division of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy.

WHEREAS the total project cost is estimated to be \$32,000, 20 percent of which would be funded through the Water Resources Division and 20 percent would be local match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Council approves the submission of the grant application to the Water Resources Division in the amount of \$32,000 for the improvements to Lakeshore Park and commits that the local match shall be provided if the project is funded.
