

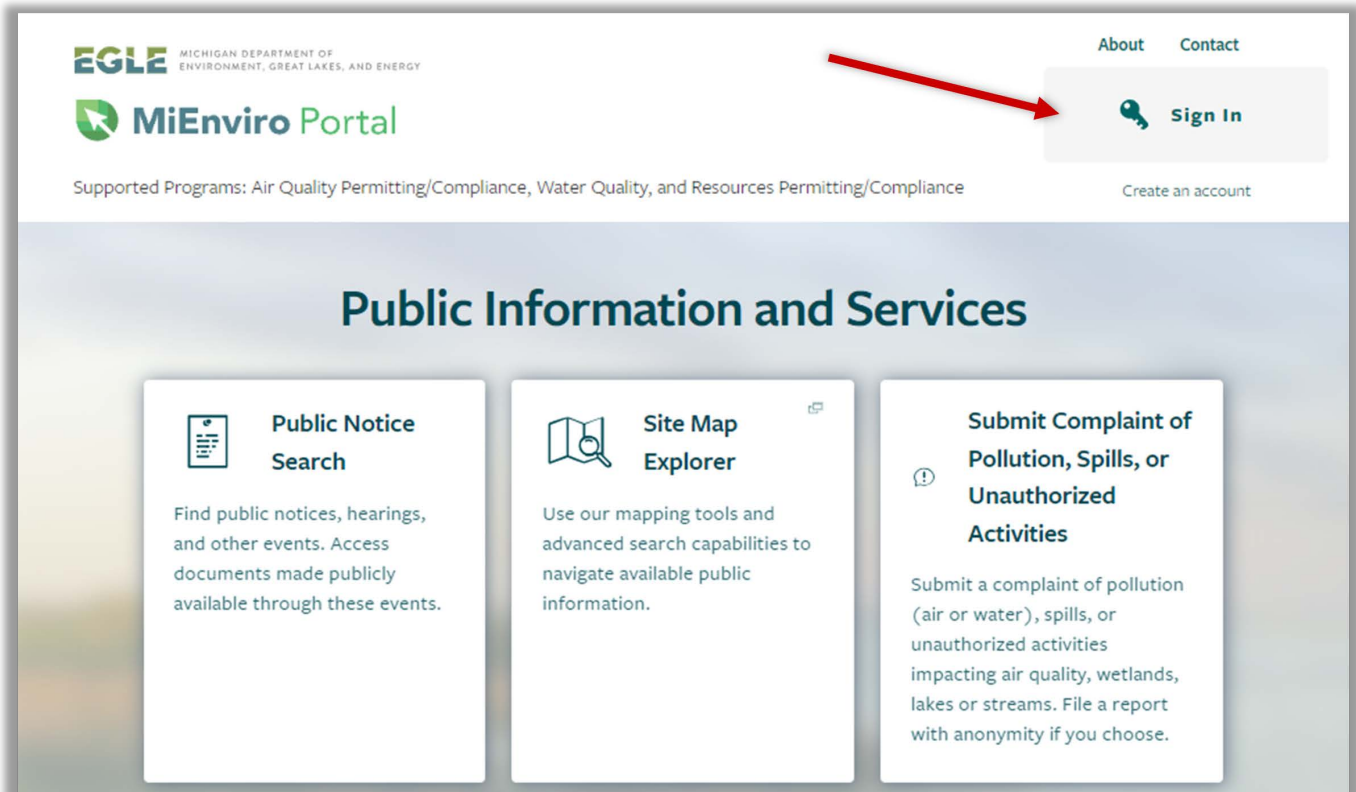
Requesting a Pre-Application Meeting through



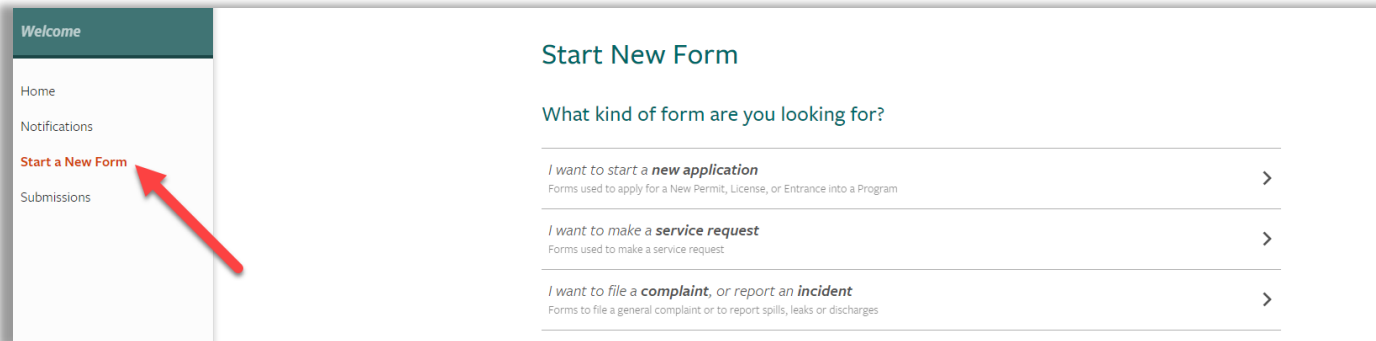
Pre-application meetings for Inland Lakes and Stream (Part 301), Wetlands Protection (Part 303) and Critical Dunes (Part 353) are requested through MiEnviro. To request a pre-application meeting you will need to create a MiEnviro Portal account at MiEnviro.michigan.gov/ncore/external/home.



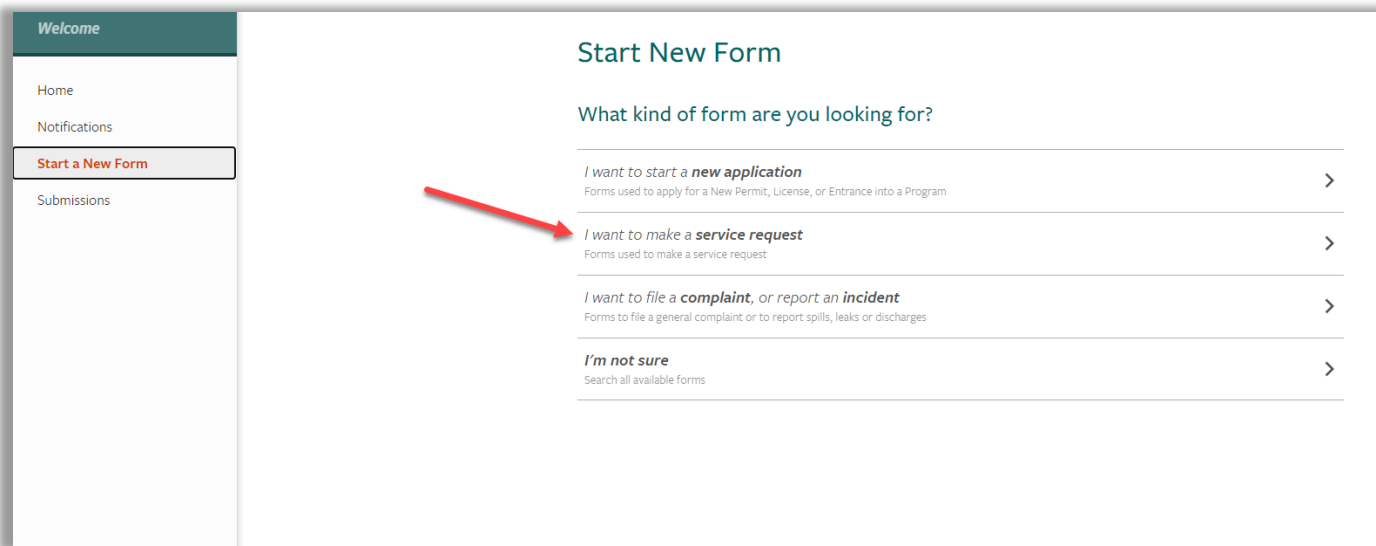
Once the account has been created, sign/log in and follow the instructions below:



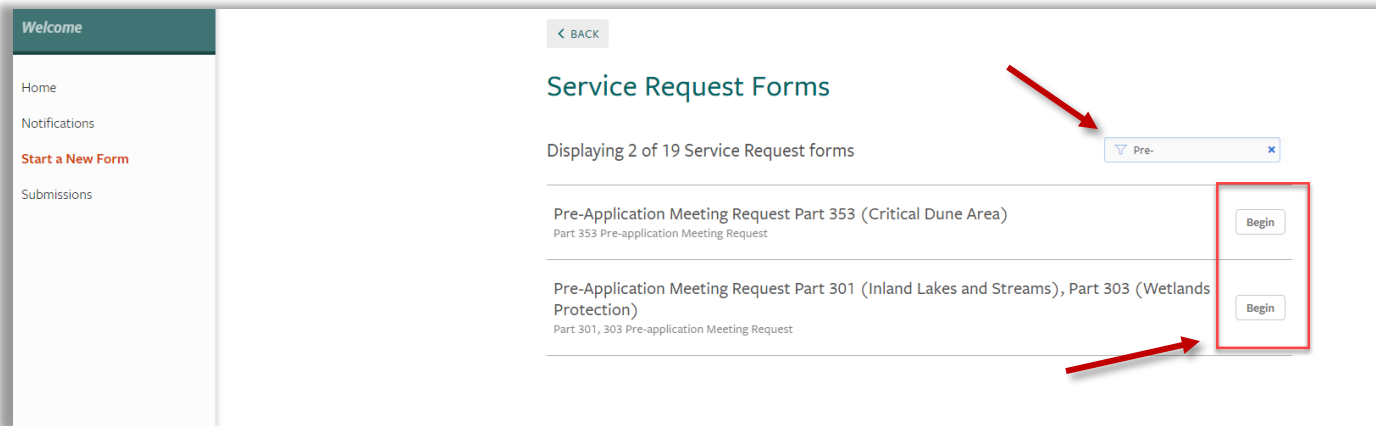
Once logged in, click on “Start a New Form.”



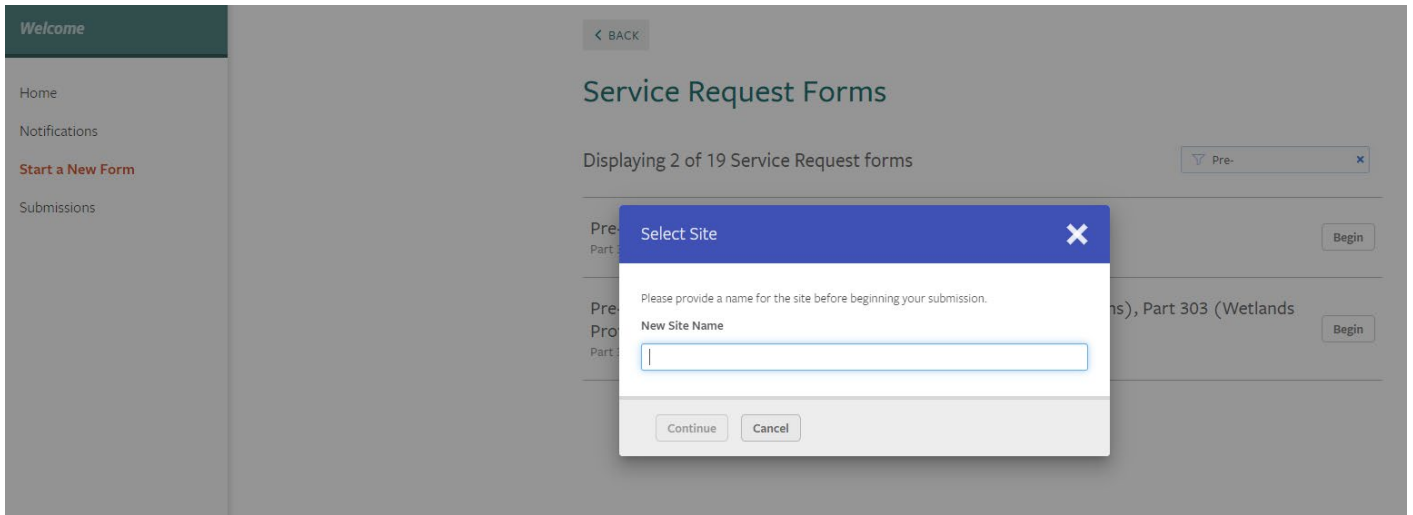
Click on “I want to make a **service request.**”



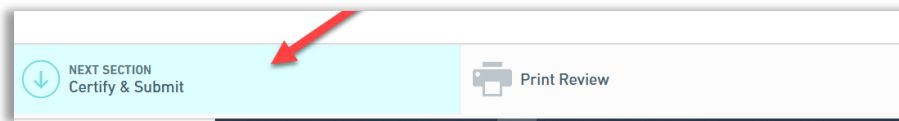
Begin typing “Pre-application” in the filter. Then click “Begin” next to the correct Pre-Application Meeting Request form.



Enter a site name (for example, the street name of the project). Click “Continue.”



From here, read the instructions for completing the form. Fill in the required fields with detailed information pertaining to your potential project. Be sure to scroll to the bottom to certify and submit the form
