

## How to Start a New Application for a Part 325 Great Lakes Bottomlands Conveyance in MiEnviro Portal







3. Select "I want to start a new application"



4. Search for "Part 325" in the search box and select "begin" next to the "Part 325 – Application for Bottomlands Conveyance" form




 Create a Site and give it a new name. The best way to name the site is: Name of Great Lakes – County Name – Project Name/Type. For example, a new marina on Lake Superior in Marquette County would be named: Lake Superior – Marquette – Marina


