SUBJECT: Report on Policy Changes Made to Implement a Public Act

In accordance with Section 221 of Article 4, Part 2, of 2022 PA 166, herein is the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy's (EGLE) report on Policy Changes Made to Implement a Public Act for calendar year 2022.

There were eight Public Acts, 243 to 250, passed in 2022 affecting EGLE that have the potential to require policy changes. Due to the breadth of these statutory updates made at the end of the calendar year, EGLE staff are still reviewing the statutory changes to determine what policy changes may be necessary. By the deadline of this report, no specific policy changes have been made to implement Public Acts 243 to 250. Any policy changes made as a result of these 2022 Public Acts will be reported with the calendar year 2023 boilerplate report.
