CLASS II WELL PERMIT APPLICATION NOTIFICATION

The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Oil, Gas, and Minerals Division (OGMD) has received a permit application for a Class II Well. In compliance with Rule 324.803(1) of Part 615, EGLE, OGMD shall mail notice to surface owners of record, and permittees of each oil, gas, and injection well within 1,320 feet of the proposed injection well, and the township supervisor or municipal manager where the well is located.

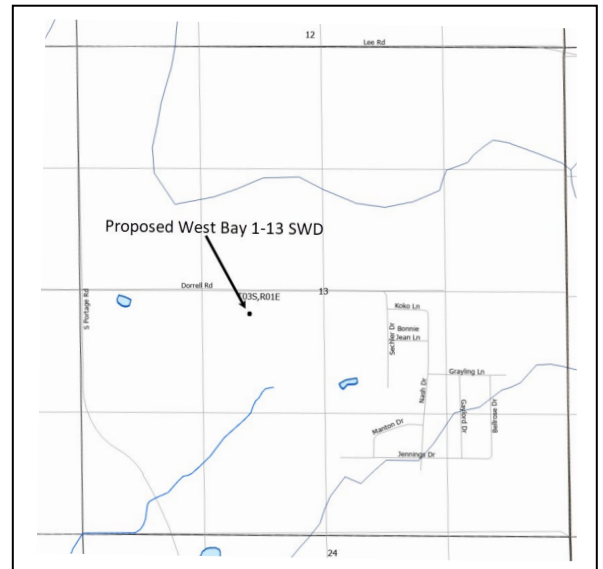

Proposed Class II well information and location:

West Bay 1-13 SWD
Section 13, T03S, R01E
Leoni Township, Jackson County

The proposed well is located approximately 489 feet southeast of the intersection of South Portage Road and Dorrell Road.



This is a proposed conversion of an existing oil well to a Class II well for the purpose of brine disposal.

The injection interval is known as the Niagaran Formation. The injection interval is found at a depth of 2,872 feet below the surface. The maximum anticipated injection pressure at the well head is 350 psi, with a maximum anticipated daily injection rate of 2,500 barrels per day.
