SUBJECT: Report on Drinking Water Laboratory Testing Fund

The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Remediation and Redevelopment Division (RRD), Laboratory Services Section, provides analytical testing of drinking water to Michigan's citizens, communities, and water supplies for the protection of public health and compliance with Michigan's Safe Drinking Water Act, 1976 PA 399, as amended.

In accordance with Section 9601(4)(a)-(c) of Part 96, State Laboratories, of the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, following is EGLE's report on the Drinking Water Laboratory Testing Fund for fiscal year (FY) 2022:

Number of Laboratory Tests Performed	118,244
Total Fees Collected/Revenue	\$3,410,700
Total Cost for Tests/Operational Expenditures	\$3,075,100

At the end of FY 2022, the Laboratory had a \$2,476,800 forwarding balance.
