AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING

Take notice that an evidentiary hearing will be held before the Supervisor of Wells (Supervisor) on the SEVENTH DAY OF OCTOBER (OCTOBER 7) 2026, BEGINNING AT 9:00 A.M. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Part 615, Supervisor of Wells; and Part 617, Unitization, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), MCL 324.61501 et seq., and the administrative rules, 1996 AACs, 2001 AACs, 2002 AACs, 2015 AACs, 2019 MR 20, R 324.101 et seq.; and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq. Pursuant to the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING STANDARD No. 2023-1, the hearing will be conducted remotely. The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) will provide notice of videoconference links or phone numbers to all parties and individuals who provide a timely answer to the petition as detailed below.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive testimony and evidence pertaining to the need or desirability of issuing an order in the matter of the petition of ReefWorks LLC (Petitioner), 333 W. Grandview Parkway, Suite 200, Traverse City, Michigan 49684.

The Petitioner seeks an order of the Supervisor approving:

(A) A unitized operation and the adoption of a plan for unit operations pursuant to Section 61704(4) of Part 617 for all formations lying between the top of the A-1 Carbonate and the base of the Lockport (Gray Niagaran), or the stratigraphic equivalents encountered in the interval from 5827' measured depth (MD) to 6343' MD, for a total interval of 516 feet, or the correlative equivalent of that interval, from the Schlumberger Gamma Ray/Sidewall Neutron Porosity Log from the Rotary Camps, Inc 1-11 well (Permit No. 30756), located in the SE/4 SW/4 SE/4 of Section 11, East Bay

Township, T26N, R10W, Grand Traverse County, Michigan (the Unitized Formation). The proposed unit area for the East Bay 15 Unit contains a total of 666 acres, more or less, and is described as:

T26N, R10W, East Bay Township, Grand Traverse County, Michigan

Section 11: S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$; E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 12: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; and the westerly 26-acres of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 14: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 15: E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

(B) An enhanced or secondary recovery operation pursuant to Section 61506(i), Part 615 of the NREPA and R 324.612. The Petitioner proposes to conduct enhanced recovery operations by injection of dry natural gas and/or other such appropriate substances as the Supervisor may approve, into the East Bay 15 Unit as described in (A).

(C) The operation of the East Bay 15 Unit as an exception to the applicable spacing and proration provisions of Special Order 1-73 and of Part 615, and its administrative rules, upon the start of unit operations.

Take note that if you wish to participate as a party in the hearing by presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses, you shall prepare and deliver to the Petitioner and the Supervisor, not less than five (5) business days before the hearing date, an answer to the petition in the manner set forth in R 324.61704 or R 324.1204(6). Proof of mailing or delivering the answer shall be filed with the Supervisor on or before the date of the hearing. The answer shall state with specificity the interested person's position with regard to the petition. Failure to prepare and serve an answer in a timely manner shall preclude you from presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses at the hearing. If an answer to the petition is not filed, the Supervisor may elect to consider the petition and enter an order without oral hearing.
