



## Executive Summary for Quarter 1, Calendar Year 2024

### Data as of July 24, 2024

This report is generated by MDHHS to track blood lead level test results in Flint, Michigan.

#### Background

- Blood lead level testing is an important part of efforts to identify people who have been harmed by lead in drinking water and other sources of lead exposure in the home. MDHHS recognizes that the full community of Flint must be the focus of the public health response.
- The CDC announced a change in the blood lead reference value (BLRV) from 5 µg/dL (micrograms lead per deciliter of blood) to 3.5 µg/dL in October 2021. MDHHS adopted the new reference value on May 1, 2022 (for more information see <https://www.michigan.gov/mdhhs/inside-mdhhs/newsroom/2022/04/29/mdhhs-updating-definition-of-elevated-blood-lead-levels>).
  - This report includes counts of BLLs above the BLRV of 3.5 µg/dL.

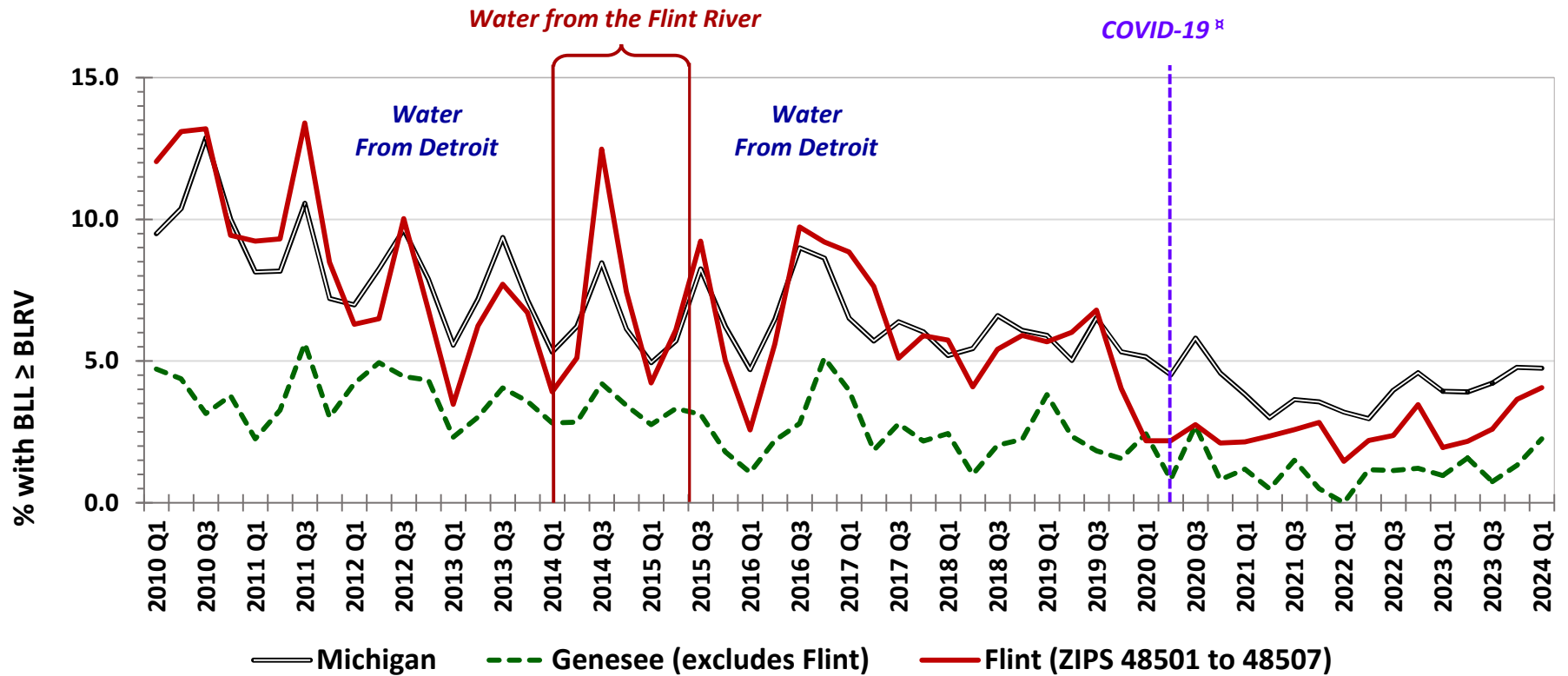
#### Data Presentation

- Each person is included only once per time period in this table.
  - If a person had multiple tests in the time period, the highest blood lead level from a venous test was counted.
  - If no venous test was performed, the highest blood lead level from a capillary test was counted.

#### Summary of Findings

- Between 10/1/2015 and 03/31/2024, 49,615 people had a blood lead test in the City of Flint in zip codes 48501-48507.
- Since 10/1/2015, 915 children under age 18 in Flint in zip codes 48501-48507 had BLLs greater than or equal to 3.5 µg/dL.
- Of the 16,161 children under age 6 tested for lead in Flint since 10/1/2015, 4.9% had BLLs greater than or equal to the BLRV of 3.5 µg/dL.
