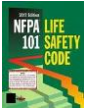

NFA 72 Fire Alarm Systems, maintenance requirements, fire watch requirements and documentation requirements.

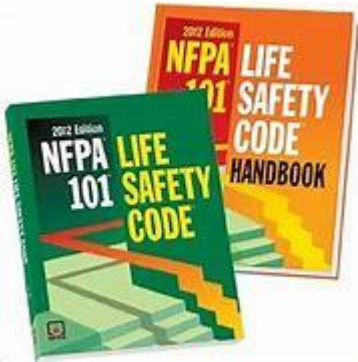


NFA 13 Sprinkler System, maintenance requirements, fire watch requirements and documentation requirements.

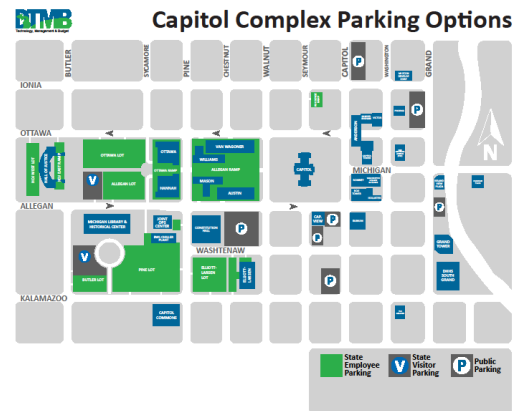
