Product Recalls for Children's Safety (not including toys)

These products have been added since issue 112 (Spring 2019)

- Walker Edison Furniture recalls children's bunk beds due to fall and injury hazards.
- RH recalls children's chairs and stools due to violation of federal lead paint ban.
- Kirkland's recalls chests of drawers due to tip-over and entrapment hazards.
- Contigo recalls kids water bottles due to choking hazard.
- Crate and Barrel recalls push walkers due to choking and laceration hazards.
- Dorel Juvenile Group USA recalls inclined sleepers due to safety concerns about inclined sleep products.
- Stokke recalls infant steps bouncers due to fall hazard.
- The Boppy Company recalls infant head and neck support accessories due to suffocation hazard.
- Universal Security Instruments recalls to inspect smoke alarms due to risk of failure to alert consumers to a fire.
- Fisher-Price recalls inclined sleeper accessory included with Ultra-Lite Day and Night Play Yards due to safety concerns about inclined sleep products.
