MOTION: It was moved by Mr. Hanselman and supported by Ms. Kelly-Person that the following penalty be assessed: A fine in the amount of \$1.00 plus administrative costs in the amount of \$999.00 made payable to the State of Michigan within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order for Complaint No. 342522. The Respondent's Professional Boxer license is suspended for ninety (90) days from the date of the Final Order with credit for time already served beyond 90 days or until the fine and costs are paid in full, whichever is later.
