MOTION: It was moved by Mr. Hanselman and supported by Mr. Hundley to accept the Stipulation as prepared. The motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

### **HEARING REPORTS**

#### **WILLIAM FROST, LICENSE NO. 15-14-000704, SUMMARY SUSPENSION 02-13-2020, FLINT, MICHIGAN: COMPLAINT NO. 342384**

MOTION: It was moved by Mr. Hanselman and supported by Mr. McKart that the following penalty be assessed: Dissolve the current Summary Suspension against Respondent's Professional Mixed Martial Artist license; a fine in the amount of \$800.00 plus administrative costs in the amount of \$2,500.00 made payable to the State of Michigan within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order for Complaint No. 342384. The Respondent's Professional Mixed Martial Artist license is suspended for ninety (90) days from the date of the Final Order with credit for time already served beyond 90 days or until the fine and costs are paid in full, whichever is later. If the fine and costs have not been paid within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order, then the Respondent's Professional Mixed Martial Artist license shall remain suspended until the fine and costs are paid in full. The motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

CODY BAKER, LICENSE NO. 15-14-000619, SUSPENDED 12-10-2019, BATTLE CREEK, MICHIGAN: COMPLAINT NO. 341672

MOTION: It was moved by Mr. Hanselman and supported by Mr. Osbern that the following penalty be assessed: A fine in the amount of \$500.00 plus administrative costs in the amount of \$2,500.00 made payable to the State of Michigan within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order for Complaint No. 341672. The Respondent's Professional Mixed Martial Artist license is suspended for sixty (60) days from the date of the Final Order or until the fine and costs are paid in full, whichever is later. If the fine and costs have not been paid within sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order, then the Respondent's Professional Mixed Martial Artist license shall remain suspended until the fine and costs are paid in full. The motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.
