FINAL ORDER

1. These matters came before the Michigan Board of Examiners in Mortuary Science (“Board”) on October 5, 2022.
2. The Board received a Corrected Hearing Report under section 514 of the Michigan Occupational Code (“Occupational Code”), MCL 339.514, in these matters, and the Board considered the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Corrected Hearing Report of David B. Marmon, Administrative Law Judge, issued and entered August 23, 2022.
3. The Corrected Hearing Report is incorporated by reference.
4. Respondents were found in violation of the Occupational Code and/or its associated administrative rules.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following penalties, authorized by sections 602 and 1810 of the Occupational Code, MCL 339.602 and MCL 339.1810, are imposed:

- A. The licenses held by Respondents under the Occupational Code are immediately REVOKED.
- B. Respondent Compassion Funeral Home & Cremation Service must pay a FINE in the amount of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$110,000.00) to the

State of Michigan. The fine must be received by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Corporations, Securities & Commercial Licensing Bureau (“Department”) no later than 60 days from the mailing date of this Final Order following the Fine Payment Instructions accompanying this Final Order.

- C. Respondent John N. Olszewski, Jr. must pay a FINE in the amount of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$170,000.00) to the State of Michigan. The fine must be received by the Department no later than 60 days from the mailing date of this Final Order following the Fine Payment Instructions accompanying this Final Order.
- D. Until the terms of this Final Order and all other outstanding final orders issued against Respondents’ licenses are met, the Department will deny any future applications for licensure or renewal submitted by Respondents under the Occupational Code.
- E. Respondents must submit in writing to the Department proof of compliance with every requirement of this Final Order in a form acceptable to the Department to the address or email address listed below.

This Final Order does not limit the Department, any other agency of the State of Michigan, or any individual from using any lawful method of collecting the fines imposed by this Final Order.

Failure to comply with the provisions of this Final Order is considered a violation of the Occupational Code, under MCL 339.604(k), and may result in further disciplinary action.

This Final Order is effective on the date mailed.
