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Executive Summary:

The *Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing and Tracking Program* report contains the reporting requirements pursuant to Section 519 of Public Act 107 of 2017.

Public Act 107 of 2017 requires the following:

Sec. 519. The department shall submit a report regarding the medical marihuana facilities licensing and tracking program to the standing committees on appropriations of the senate and house, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget director by March 1. The report shall include, but is not limited to, the following:

- (a) The number of initial license applications received for each license category.
- (b) The number of initial applications approved and the number of initial license applications denied.
- (c) The average amount of time, from receipt to approval or denial, to process an initial application.
- (d) The number of license applications approved by license category and county.
- (e) The total amount collected from application fees.
- (f) The total amount collected from any established regulatory assessment.
- (g) The costs of administering the medical marihuana facilities licensing and tracking program.

Pursuant to these requirements, this report has been prepared and issued electronically to the House and Senate appropriations standing committees, House and Senate Fiscal Agencies, and the state budget director to meet the March 1 reporting requirement. Executive Background:

The Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Program (MMFLP) is a state licensing and regulatory program within the Bureau of Medical Marihuana Regulation, Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). The program administers the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act and Marihuana Tracking Act. The program implements the statutory tenets of this act in a manner that protects the public and promotes business growth.
