- 2. If I had a judgment of guilt in a criminal proceeding or a civil action against me; I am rehabilitated, or the substance of my former offense is not reasonably related to the occupation or profession for which I am seeking a license.

If you do not believe you can answer "YES" to these statements and would like the Department to make a nonbinding preliminary determination concerning whether any court judgments against you would likely result in a denial of license or registration for failing to meet the Good Moral Character requirement for that license or registration, please submit a detailed description of the offense(s), including an explanation of what took place and date(s) of occurrence(s), along with this request form.

To ensure that the preliminary determination made by the department is an accurate prediction of whether you will meet the Good Moral Character requirements when applying for a license, you <u>may</u> wish to submit additional supporting documentation with this request, including: court documents and other documentation, if any, that shows at the current time you have the ability and are likely to serve the public in a fair, honest, and open manner; that you are rehabilitated; or that the substance of the former offense is not reasonably related to the occupation or skilled trade for which you may be seeking licensure.

Preliminary determinations are based solely upon the information provided and documents submitted with your request.

I understand that the Department or a Board is not bound by a preliminary determination issued if I apply for a license or registration under this act. The issuance of a preliminary determination under this section does not limit the authority of the Department to review applications for a license or registration, or to issue or deny a license or registration.
