FINAL DECISION OF THE ELECTRICAL ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD

On November 2, 2023, the Electrical Administrative Board (“Board”) was presented with a Construction Code Appeal Application for Ann Arbor Public Schools – Wines Elementary School, located at 1701 Newport Road, Ann Arbor, Michigan, submitted by Brian Koepp. Notification was made to Brian Koepp on October 20, 2023, that this matter would be addressed by the Board at the meeting on November 2, 2023. The Board acknowledged receipt of the request on November 2, 2023, reviewed the application and all supplemental materials provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230.

Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed unanimously to deny the Construction Code Appeal due to the electrical equipment installed not being listed; therefore, the applicant would need to obtain a field evaluation as outlined in the Bureau of Construction Codes’ November 2, 2023, Memorandum.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Board to deny the Construction Code Appeal for Ann Arbor Public School – Wines Elementary School. A governmental subdivision that receives a disapproval may resubmit its application for approval.

Notification was made to David Beckering on October 20, 2023, that this matter would be addressed by the Board at the meeting on November 2, 2023. The Board acknowledged receipt of the request on November 2, 2023, reviewed the application and all supplemental materials provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230.

Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed unanimously to deny the Construction Code Appeal due to no adequate evidence provided for the Board to approve the appeal as outlined in the Bureau of Construction Codes’ November 2, 2023, Memorandum.
