FINAL DECISION OF THE ELECTRICAL ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD

On July 19, 2023, the Construction Code Commission reviewed the Application for Construction Code Appeal submitted by Union Electric for Southern Regional Warehouse, 1994 East Parnall, Jackson, MI, Jackson County. Mr. Jim Lawrence of Union Electric appealed four violations of the 2017 Michigan Electrical Code Sections 240.21, 695.3(E) and 695.6(A)(2)(d). The application and all supplemental materials were acknowledged and reviewed by the Commission. The Commission, then, referred the appeal to the Electrical Administrative Board. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS: Notification was made to Mr. Jim Lawrence on July 28, 2023, that this matter would be addressed by the Electrical Administrative Board at the meeting on August 10, 2023. The Board acknowledged receipt and reviewed the material on this matter at the meeting on August 10, 2023. Mr. Al Keown, Mr. Joe Sovis, PE, Matrix Consulting Engineers, Inc., and Mr. Mucci, State Electrical Inspector appeared before and presented to the Board. Following discussion, the Board unanimously moved to deny Union Electric's appeal for failure to comply with the requirements of the 2017 Michigan Electrical Code.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Electrical Administrative Board to deny Union Electric's Application for Construction Code Appeal challenging four violations of the 2017 Michigan Electrical Code Sections 240.21, 695.3(E) and 695.6(A)(2)(d). A person aggrieved by this decision may petition the Construction Code Commission to review the decision, as provided in MCL 125.1516.

FINAL DECISION OF THE ELECTRICAL ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD

On July 19, 2023, the Construction Code Commission reviewed the Application for Construction Code Appeal submitted by CTC Engineering, LLC for Henry Ford College/Energy Center, 5101 Evergreen Road, Dearborn, MI, Wayne County. CTC Engineering, LLC requested violations be overturned relating to 2017 Michigan Electrical Code Sections 110.3(B), 240.21(C)(6) [cited in the application as 240.2(C)(6)], 250.30(A)(4), 250.102(C)(2), 392.60(B)(4), and 392.10(B). The application and all supplemental materials were acknowledged and reviewed by the Commission. The Commission, then, referred the appeal to the Electrical Administrative Board. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS: Notification was made to Mr. Glenn Keates of CTC Engineering on July 28, 2023, that this matter would be addressed by the Electrical Administrative Board at the meeting on August 10, 2023. The Board acknowledged receipt and reviewed the material on this matter at the meeting on August 10, 2023. Mr. Keates, CTC Engineering, and Mr. Kris Mucci, State Electrical Inspector, appeared before and presented to the Board. Following discussion, the Board unanimously moved to deny CTC Engineering LLC's appeal because it does not comply with the 25 feet requirement in Section 240.21 and Henry Ford Community College is not an industrial establishment under Section 240.10(B) of the 2017 Michigan Electrical Code.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Electrical Administrative Board to deny CTC Engineering, LLC's Application for Construction Code Appeal of violations relating to 2017 Michigan Electrical Code Sections 110.3(B), 240.21(C)(6), 250.30(A)(4), 250.102(C)(2), 392.60(B)(4), and 392.10(B). A person aggrieved by this decision may petition the Construction Code Commission to review the decision, as provided in MCL 125.1516.

FINAL DECISION OF THE ELECTRICAL ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD

On July 19, 2023, the Construction Code Commission reviewed the Application for Construction Code Appeal submitted by Troy Adams regarding his residence located at 67135 M-62, Township of Jefferson, Cass County. After not receiving a response from the Township of Jefferson's Construction Board of Appeals, Mr. Adams appealed to the State Construction Code Commission for a determination on if he was eligible for an electrical permit to install critical load sub circuit for emergency power. The application and all supplemental materials were acknowledged and reviewed by the Commission. The Commission, then, referred the appeal to the Electrical Administrative Board. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS: Notification was made to Mr. Troy Adams and Mr. Dean Hass, Township of Jefferson Supervisor, on July 28, 2023, that this matter would be addressed by the Electrical Administrative Board at the meeting on August 10, 2023. The Board acknowledged receipt and reviewed the material on this matter at the meeting on August 10, 2023. Mr. Adams, Mr. Bill LaBre, attorney, and Mr. Ron Bellaire, Township of Jefferson Electrical Inspector, appeared before and presented to the Board. Following discussion, the Board unanimously moved to approve Mr. Adams' Application for Construction Code Appeal concluding he was eligible to apply for a permit.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Electrical Administrative Board to approve Mr. Adams to be eligible to apply for an electrical permit for his solar array. A person aggrieved by this decision may petition the Construction Code Commission to review the decision, as provided in MCL 125.1516.
