#### **DECISION OF THE ELEVATOR SAFETY BOARD**

On December 13, 2022, the Elevator Safety Board reviewed the Variance Request for Oakland University South Foundation Hall; Variance 2 located at 308 Meadow Brook Road, Rochester, MI 48309 for relief from the requirements of Sections 2.2.7, 2.4.1.1, 2.4.1.3, and 2.4.1.6 of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) A17.1-2010. This decision is issued pursuant to Section 8(1)(c) of the Elevator Safety Board Act, 1967 PA 227.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS: Notification was made to Mr. Wildenhaus on November 29, 2022, that this matter would be addressed by the Elevator Safety Board at the meeting on December 13, 2022. The Board acknowledged receipt and reviewed the material on the matter at the meeting on December 13, 2022. Mr. Wildenhaus was present to provide testimony. Following discussion, the Board moved to deny Mr. Wildenhaus' variance request due to no refuge space and no measurement could be provided; therefore, there is loss of a level of safety.

THEREFORE, it is the decision of the Elevator Safety Board to deny relief for Mr. Wildenhaus' variance request from the requirements of Sections 2.2.7, 2.4.1.1, 2.4.1.3, and 2.4.1.6 of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) A17.1-2010. A judicial review of this decision may be requested in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 *et seq*.

Pursuant to MCL 408.808 and Executive Order 2017-3, Mr. Brandon Bunkelman's appeal regarding the Bureau of Construction Codes' decision to deny his application for an elevator journeyman's license was presented in a regularly scheduled, public meeting before the Elevator Safety Board on December 13, 2022. After considering the parties' written submissions and oral arguments, the Elevator Safety Board unanimously voted to recommend that the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs affirm the denial of Mr. Bunkelman's application for an elevator journeyman's license.

On February 16, 2023, the Elevator Safety Board issued a written recommendation that the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs deny Mr. Bunkelman's appeal, and affirm the Bureau of Construction Codes' decision to deny his application for an elevator journeyman's license because he failed to establish the necessary experience requirements in MCL 338.2156.

#### **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

After reviewing the record of Mr. Bunkelman's application and appeal and considering the recommendation of the Elevator Safety Board, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs denies Mr. Brandon Bunkelman's appeal and affirms the Bureau of Construction Codes' decision to deny Mr. Bunkelman an elevator journeyman's license due to a lack of experience as required by MCL 338.2156.
