FINAL DECISION OF THE BOARD OF MECHANICAL RULES

On February 23, 2022, the Board of Mechanical Rules was presented with Barbara Vader's variance request for a pizza oven located at Western Michigan University, Student Center and Dining Facility, 1951 Hayes Drive, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49008. Ms. Vader requested a variance for relief of requirements of Section 507.2 of the 2015 Michigan Mechanical Code (MMC). The Board acknowledged receipt of the request on February 23, 2022, reviewed the material provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.15.

Ms. Barbara Vader, Mr. Andrew Johnson, PBA, and Mr. Brian Baganick, Hobbs & Black attended the meeting, spoke in support of the variance request, and answered questions from the Board. Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to approve Ms. Vader's variance request for Western Michigan University, Student Center and Dining Facility as submitted.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Board of Mechanical Rules to approve relief from the requirements of Section 507.2 of the 2015 MMC. An appeal of this decision may be requested in accordance with Section 16 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1516.

On February 23, 2022, the Board of Mechanical Rules was presented with Ms. Susan Israel's variance request for a pizza oven located at Emma Hearth and Market, 9301 Red Arrow Highway, Haymarket, Michigan. Ms. Israel requested a variance for relief of requirements of Section 507.2 of the 2015 Michigan Mechanical Code (MMC). The Board acknowledged receipt of the request on February 23, 2022, reviewed the material provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 15 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.15.

Mr. Steve Zieverink and Mr. Joe Infante, Miller Canfield attended the meeting, spoke in support of the variance request, and answered questions from the Board. Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to approve Ms. Israel's variance request for Emma Hearth and Market based on the manufacturer's recommendations, that it is only used for baking, and to include both wood and gas fuels.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Board of Mechanical Rules to approve relief from the requirements of Section 507.2 of the 2015 MMC. An appeal of this decision may be requested in accordance with Section 16 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1516.
