### **FINAL DECISION OF THE BOARD OF MECHANICAL RULES**

On August 17, 2022, the Board of Mechanical Rules was presented with Mr. Robert Gaines' Petition Application for Certificate of Acceptability Ladderport Ladder Receiver up to 24 feet on buildings other than new construction. The Board acknowledged receipt of the application on August 17, 2022, reviewed the material provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. This final decision is issued pursuant to MCL 339.5805(5) of 2016 PA 407, Skilled Trades Regulation Act.

Mr. Robert Gaines, Laddertech LLC dba Ladderport, attended the meeting and spoke in support of his application. Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to deny Mr. Gaines' Petition Application for Certificate of Acceptability as the request is being made regarding changes in the Proposed 2018 Construction Code – Part 9A. Mechanical Code Rules which have not yet been adopted.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Board of Mechanical Rules to deny the Petition Application for Certificate of Acceptability for the Ladderport Ladder Receiver up to 24 feet on buildings other than new construction as presented as the request is being made regarding changes in the Proposed 2018 Construction Code – Part 9A.
