Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to deny Mr. Cooper's appeal due to the fact that he failed to meet the requirement of having 2 years of experience, immediately preceding his date of application.

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the State Plumbing Board to deny Mr. Cooper's appeal due to not meeting the licensure requirements for the master plumbing examination set forth in MCL 339.6113 of 2016 PA 407. Judicial review of this decision may be pursued in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*
