Pursuant to MCL 339.6105 and Executive Order 2017-3, Mr. Leon Starkey's appeal regarding the Bureau of Construction Codes' decision to deny his application for master plumbing examination was presented in a regularly scheduled, public meeting before the State Plumbing Board on April 16, 2025. After considering the parties' written submissions and oral arguments, the State Plumbing Board voted to recommend that the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs affirm the denial of Mr. Starkey's appeal regarding his application for a master plumbing examination.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

After reviewing the record of Mr. Starkey's application and appeal and considering the recommendation of the State Plumbing Board, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs denies Mr. Starkey's appeal and affirms the Bureau of Construction Codes' decision to deny Mr. Starkey's appeal regarding his application for master plumbing examination due to a lack of time as a licensed journey plumber immediately preceding application as required by MCL 339.6113(1)(d). While the appeal is denied, the application shall remain open, as Mr. Starkey should meet requirements to be approved to test in July 2025, provided he submits updated notarized statements from his employer attesting to the requirements outlined in MCL 339.6113(1)(d).
