4. <u>PETITION - RECOMMENDATION REVIEW</u>

A. Petition No. 20-AP-01 Township of Hopkins to City of Wayland

The Commission reviewed Petition No. 20-AP-01 for annexation of land area in the Township of Hopkins to City of Wayland in accordance with MCL 123.1009.

Following discussion, a **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Datema and **SECONDED** by Commissioner Preston to recommend denial of Petition No. 20-AP-01 by the Director of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs as AAG Fitzgerald has confirmed a 425 agreement is in place which insulates the area from annexation. Pursuant to Executive Reorganization Order 1996-2, this denial is contingent on the concurrence of the Director of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. County Commission Members appointed for Allegan County were dismissed along with any public attending for Petition No. 20-AP-01 that chose to leave.

5. <u>PETITION – LEGAL SUFFICIENCY REVIEW</u>

A. Petition No. 21-AP-01 Township of Lapeer to City of Lapeer

The Commission reviewed Petition No. 21-AP-01 for annexation of land area in the Township of Lapeer to City of Lapeer in accordance with MCL 123.1009.

Following discussion, a **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Datema and **SECONDED** by Chairperson Beltramini to deny Petition No. 21-AP-01 for annexation of land area in the Township of Lapeer to City of Lapeer to be found legally sufficient as a 425 agreement is in place which insulates the area from annexation. Additionally, there is a PA 7 agreement that may also be in place. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

8. BUREAU QUARTERLY REPORT

The Bureau continues to work with auditors regarding their findings during its 2020 audit, and BCC is addressing any issues with resources the Bureau has.

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Mike Barger and Janelle Campbell left the Bureau in March 2022. The Bureau is in the process of back-filling Mr. Barger's position first. Then, the Bureau will work to back-fill Ms. Campbell's position. A portion of the State Boundary Commission functions will stay with the Office of Land Survey & Remonumentation and the remaining functions will move to the Administrative Service Division.

9. PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Michael Gildner, Simen, Figura & Parker, P.L.C., commented he agrees with the State Boundary Commission's decision that there is a 425 agreement in place.

Mr. Mark Leichliter, Rickard, Denney, Garno, Leichliter & Childers, commented he disagrees that there is a 425 agreement in place but that the State Boundary Commission has the authority to make its decision.

Mr. Brian Silvernail, petitioner for Petition No. 20-AP-01, commented that the 425 agreement is a sham and the decision is now being delayed indefinitely.

Mr. Kalvin Schanz, property owner for Petition No. 20-AP-01, questioned the benefit of a 425 agreement and stated some of the property in the petition has been sold to the Gun Lake Native American Tribe.
