

Obtaining a
Plumbing
Contractor
License in the
State of
Michigan

Applicants must either be licensed as plumbing master OR employ at least 1 licensed plumbing master as the master plumber of record.

Plumbing contractor can operator 1 or more branches if a licensed plumbing master is in charge and has the responsibility of supervision at each branch

If a plumbing contractor is represented by a licensed plumbing master who ceases to represent the company the department must be notified within 30 days.

Hold and maintain a Master Plumber License OR employ at least 1 full time employee who is a licensed master plumber who is designated as the master plumber of record.



Apply for licensure

Plumbing Contractor licensure:

1. Must be a licensed plumbing master
OR
2. Employ at least 1 licensed plumbing master as the master plumber of record.
3. Submit completed application to state of Michigan.
4. Take and pass appropriate test.
