This letter is a follow-up to the March 1, 2017, teleconference between the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Office of Manufactured Housing Programs (OMHP) staff and with you and Barbara Kunkel of the Bureau of Construction Codes, Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.

The OMHP received your letter dated February 8, 2017, addressing HUD's concerns with the State of Michigan's responses to the State Administrative Agency (SAA) Monitoring Assessment worksheet, and your letter dated February 13, 2017, in which the Bureau of Construction Codes notified HUD of its withdrawal from performing as an SAA.

In addition to the SAA program, the Bureau of Construction Codes has informed HUD that the State of Michigan is no longer participating in the Manufactured Home Installation and Dispute Resolution Programs. The discontinuance of Michigan's participation in these Federal programs will become effective on May 15, 2017.

Should the State of Michigan wish to partner again with HUD in the SAA, Installation, and/or Dispute Resolution Programs, a letter should be sent to the Secretary, adhering to the guidelines outlined in 24 Code of Federal Regulations 3282 – Subpart G, 3286 – Subpart I, and 3288 – Subpart D.

The Department wishes to thank you and your staff for your diligence and cooperation in this matter.
