Per the National Fire Academy (NFA): This **FREE** two-day course is designed to provide students with an understanding of the Incident Command System (ICS) and resource management for the fire service and their application in both emergency and non-emergency situations.

This course addresses the need for an ICS, an overview of the structure and flexibility of ICS, an understanding of the command skills necessary to function effectively in an ICS structure, and the need to effectively manage your resources.

Application/Registration: Students must complete and upload their IS-100 and IS-200 certificates into MI-TRAIN. Students must bring their current FEMA SID number to the course, as a FEMA application will be completed by all students enrolled in the course.

Space is limited to 24 students. Student selection for the course is the responsibility of the Michigan State Police-Emergency Management and Homeland Security Training Center (MSP-EMHSTC), based upon a determination of an equal participation ratio from all areas of the state of Michigan.
