This is the first of four training sessions at the Copper Country Live Fire Training Facility sponsored by the Keweenaw County Fire Training Committee in 2022. This session will be dedicated to the utilization of self contained breathing apparatus in a controlled, smoke filled environment to ensure thorough equipment familiarization and as a confidence builder for all personnel. The training will also include familiarization and utilization of thermal imaging devices. Although a fire will be maintained for smoke and heat purposes, there will be no actual firefighting or extensive water supply operations conducted during this session.

ELIGIBILITY & PREREQUISITES: Eighteen years of age or older on the class date and membership within an organized Michigan fire department and Firefighter 1 certification.

REGISTRATION: Register in SMOKE. Contrary to the instructions, there is no need to contact the Course Manager at this time.

MATERIALS REQUIRED: All participants will be required to bring full PPE, including an SCBA with two cylinders. Departments may bring any apparatus they feel necessary. Additionally, fluids for hydration and lunch are student responsibilities.

STUDENT COST: Zero. This course is funded with Keweenaw County fire training funds.
